1	<p>Due to the curfew imposed by local authorities in Basrah, only three bidders were able to attend the Site visit .</p> <p>Meanwhile, the focal Engineer received several questions from other five bidders through phone calls, as the telephone line was open to facilitate the process for interested bidders but could not reach the site due to current restrictions.
