Location of activities:	Activities will be conducted in targeted communities in target parishes.			
Coordination & reporting mechanism:	This activity will be undertaken in close collaboration with the Ministry of Culture, Gender, Entertainment and Sports and other representatives from government, non-government organizations and UN agencies. The CSO(s) will be expected to report directly to UNICEF.			
Inputs/services to be provided by UN agency:	In partnership with relevant stakeholders, UNICEF will provide the CSO(s) with relevant background materials and technical tools. UNICEF will also facilitate the convening and liaising with government institutions and other actors involved in programme delivery.			
Other relevant information or special conditions, if any:	Recent developments regarding COVID-19 may cause delays in some of the activities planned. The UN will continue to closely monitor the situation and may alter implementation timeframes accordingly.			
Allocated budget:	40,000 USD dollars over a period of 2 years
