Background

As the flagship model of community eco-lodges in Eswatini, Shewula Mountain Camp has received a great deal of publicity as an Eco-tourism destination. Ecotourism is a form of tourism that seeks to attract local and international visitors by preserving and offering the natural environment, sustainable ways of living and biodiversity as attractions. It showcases the natural treasures that Eswatini has as well as teaches the world about the history, cultural and traditional heritage of Emaswati for a reasonable return on investment. The Shewula Mountain Camp is a community owned project governed by a team of board of trustees on behalf the community.

The Shewula Mountain Camp is a successful community venture offering a number of furnished Rondavel/chalets, a kitchen, ablution block and camping areas. Hot water, electricity fridges and stoves are also available. The Shewula Mountain Camp seeks to diversify its accommodation mix by developing a bee-hive hut for its tourists. Swazi traditional beehive huts are made of poles, thatch and other special grass crafted ropes.

Job Description

The SNPAS project calls for quotations from national companies that have the capacity to construct and supply building and thatching material to support the Shewula mountain camp in constructing a beehive hut. The goal is strengthening community eco-tourism through improvement and development of eco-tourism infrastructure in order to improve visitor experience and bed occupancy.

Objectives

The project objective is to effectively expand, manage and develop Eswatini's protected area network in order to adequately protect the biodiversity and landscapes of the country. This activity contributes to the objective of strengthening community eco-tourism through supporting the rehabilitation of eco-tourism infrastructure.
