Your Proposal must be expressed in the **English or Ukrainian or Russian**, and valid for a minimum period of **90** days.

In the course of preparing your Proposal, it shall remain your responsibility to ensure that it reaches the address above on or before the deadline. Proposals that are received by UNDP after the deadline indicated above, for whatever reason, shall not be considered for evaluation. If you are submitting your Proposal by email, kindly ensure that they are signed and in the .pdf format, and free from any virus or corrupted files.

NB. The Offeror shall create 2 archive files (\*.zip format only!): one should include *technical proposal*, another one should include *financial proposal* and be encrypted with password. Both files should be attached to the email letter.

During evaluation process only technically compliant companies will be officially asked by UNDP procurement unit via email to provide password to archive with financial proposal. Please do not include the password either to email letter or technical proposal and disclose before official request.

Messages should **not exceed 8 MB in size**. Offers larger than 8 MB should be split into several messages and each message subject should indicate "part x of y" besides the marking mentioned in the announcement and the solicitation documents. Messages larger than 8 Mb may not be delivered. *All electronic submissions are confirmed by an automatic reply*.

The Offeror shall mark the email letter/s:

If the Service Provider does not accept the final price based on UNDP's re-computation and correction of errors, its Proposal will be rejected.

#### \*\* Dear partners!

The United Nations Office in Ukraine would like to inform you that the purchase of goods and services announced in the tender will be carried out within the project of international technical assistance.

According to the provisions of the Tax Code of Ukraine (paragraph 197.11), an exemption from VAT is provided for operations that are financed through material and technical assistance.

The procedure for obtaining the right to exemption from taxation for operations that are made within international technical assistance projects is regulated by the Decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No.153 dated February 15, 2002.

According to this procedure, the price of the contract is determined "without VAT" and the tax invoice is drawn up in accordance with paragraph 2 of Order No. 1307. In the left part of this invoice, the corresponding mark "X" should be made and the type of reason 12 should be indicated. At the same time in the column "Recipient" (buyer) the name of the legal entity (UN Office in Ukraine) should be indicated, and in the column "Individual tax number of the beneficiary" (buyer) should be indicated conventional TIN (taxpayer reg. No.) "2000000000000".

Based on the above stated, we request that you prepare your bid proposals / invoices for payment without VAT taking into account the provisions of the Ukrainian legislation stated in the abovementioned normative acts.

Согласно положений Налогового Кодекса Украины (п. 197.11) предусмотрено освобождение от налогообложения НДС операций, которые финансируются за счет материально-технической помощи.

Порядок получения права на освобождение от налогообложения операций, которые производятся в рамках проектов международной технической помощи регламентируется постановлением Кабинета Министров Украины от 15 февраля 2002 года №153.

В случае наличия права на применение этой НДС-ной льготы на дату получения аванса от ПРООН вы должны составить и зарегистрировать в ЕРНН налоговую накладную (далее — НН), которая заполняется следующим образом:

- в графе «Складена на операції, звільнені від оподаткування» верхней левой части делается пометка «Без ПДВ»;
- в раздел А табличной части НН (строки I X) вносятся обобщающие данные по операциям, на которые складывается такая НН, а именно: в строке I указывается общая сумма средств, подлежащих уплате с учетом НДС; в строке IX общий объем поставки товаров/услуг. Строки II VIII раздела А не заполняются;
- в графе 2 раздела В указывается номенклатура услуг поставщика (продавца);
- в графа 3.3 раздела В код услуги согласно ГКПУ. Графа 3.3 заполняются на всех этапах поставки услуг.
- в графе 4 и 5 единица измерения услуг;
- в графе 6 количество (объем) поставки услуг;
- в графе 7 цена поставки единицы услуги без учета НДС;
- в графе 8 указывается код ставки НДС 903;
- в графе 9 код льготы согласно Справочнику других налоговых льгот налоговых льгот, утвержденному ГФС по состоянию на дату составления НН «14060523».
- в графе 10 объем поставки без учета НДС (сумма аванса). Детально в материалах «Налоговая накладная 2017: порядок заполнения» и «Новая налоговая накладная в образцах».

Что касается налогового кредита с НДС по покупкам материалов для выполнения соответствующих строительных работ, то здесь правила его компенсации, предусмотренные п. 198.5 НКУ, не действуют. Ведь согласно п. 198.5 НКУ на операции по поставке товаров и услуг, освобождение от налогообложения НДС которых предусмотрено п. 197.11 НКУ, правила начисления налоговых обязательств не распространяются.

Это значит, что в ходе использования материалов, которые покупались с НДС, для выполнения данных работ налоговый кредит компенсировать не нужно, соответственно не нужно и начислять для этого налоговые обязательства.

Исходя из вышесказанного, просим Вас формировать Ваши тендерные заявки/счета на оплату без НДС учитывая положения украинского законодательства, изложенного в перечисленных нормативных актах.

В случае возникновения дополнительных вопросов просим Вас обращаться в отделения Государственной Фискальной Службы Украины по месту регистрации Вашего предприятия для получения дополнительной консультации в рамках статьи 52 Налогового Кодекса Украины.

## I. BACKGROUND

The ongoing conflict in eastern Ukraine has had a direct and highly negative impact on economy, social cohesion, resilience, livelihoods, community security, and the rule of law. Recognizing the need to urgently address reconstruction, economic recovery and peacebuilding needs in areas affected both directly and indirectly by the conflict, in late 2014 the Government of Ukraine requested technical assistance and financial support from the international community to assess priority recovery needs. In late 2014, the United Nations (UN), the World Bank (WB) and the European Union (EU) conducted a Recovery and Peacebuilding Assessment, which was endorsed by the Cabinet of Ministers in mid-2015.

The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) has been active and present in eastern Ukraine for the past decade, prior to the conflict, with a focus on community development, civil society development, and environmental protection. Work on addressing the specific conflict-related development challenges discussed above built on this earlier engagement, established partnerships, and started in 2015 through the United Nations Recovery and Peacebuilding Programme (UN RPP). The UN RPP is a multi-donor funded framework programme formulated and led by the UNDP in collaboration with the Government of Ukraine and in cooperation with a number of partnering UN agencies (UN Women, FAO, UNFPA).

The RPP was designed to respond to, and mitigate, the causes and effects of the conflict. It is based on findings of the Recovery and Peacebuilding Assessment (RPA) and is aligned to the State Target Programme for Recovery as well as to the two oblast development strategies up to 2020. It takes into account the opportunities that have arisen from the Minsk Protocol of September 2014 and the renewal of its cease-fire provisions (the latest cease-fire having been agreed in March 2018) and is also fully adjusted to the humanitarian-development nexus. It is an integral component of the UNDP Country Programme and is therefore fully aligned with the United Nations Partnership Framework (UNPF). It is closely interlinked

with the Democratic Governance and Reform Programme, operating nationally and in all of Ukraine's regions, and is consistent with the SDGs.

The Programme's interventions are grouped under the following key Programme components, which reflect the region's priority needs:

Component 1: Economic Recovery and Restoration of Critical Infrastructure

Component 2: Local Governance and Decentralization Reform

Component 3: Community Security and Social Cohesion.

The Programme, which operates on the basis of a pooled funding arrangement, follows a multi-sectoral programme-based approach and is implemented using an area-based methodology. It is a unifying interventions framework for 12 projects funded by 12 international partners and is worth over 80 million USD.

In October 2018, four UN agencies (UNDP, UN Women, FAO and the UNFPA) have countersigned a new joint project document, funded by the EU. The overall objective of the project is to restore effective governance, support economic recovery and promote reconciliation in the crisis-affected communities of Donetsk, Luhansk and Zaporizhzhia oblasts in Ukraine, thereby enhancing the credibility and legitimacy of local governments in the government-controlled areas of the regions. It will contribute to peace build and prevent further escalation of conflict in Ukraine through effective and accountable decentralization, gender-responsive recovery planning and equal access to services, as well as enhanced economic recovery and development.

This endeavor will be achieved through the pursuit of the following specific objectives:

- 1. Enhancing local capacity for gender-responsive decentralization and administrative reforms to improve governance, local development and the delivery of services.
- 2. Stimulating employment and economic growth by providing assistance to Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSME) development through demand-driven business development services and professional skills training.
- 3. Enhancing social cohesion and reconciliation through promotion of civic initiatives.
- 4. Supporting sector reforms and structural adjustments in health, education and critical public infrastructure to mitigate direct impacts of the conflict and enhance the capacity of governmental authorities for national the coordination of actions to cope with emergencies arising from the conflict zone.
- 5. Supporting the implementation of the European Investment Bank's Early Recovery Programme.

The ongoing COVID-19 crisis is challenging people, households and businesses in unprecedented ways. While containing the pandemic and protecting people is the top priority, disrupted supply chains, containment measures that are limiting economic and social interactions and falling demand put people's jobs and income-generation opportunities at risk. According to ILO, the economic and labour crisis created by the COVID-19 pandemic could increase global unemployment by almost 25 million people (7.4 million people in middle-income countries) and the overall losses in labour income might reach USD 3.4 trillion (USD 14.8 billion in middle-income countries). According to Ukraine's leading investment bank, national GDP will decline by 4% if the countrywide lockdown lasts up to three months and by 9% if it lasts longer. The crisis especially affects MSMEs that have significantly lower reserves and resilience than large business. Ukrainian Chamber of Commerce and Industry reported that up to 700 000 enterprises, which give employment to 3,5 – 4 million people, have already stopped their business activity due to the lockdown and inability to operate in the changed market conditions. These figures constitute some 25% of all businesses and labour workers active in Ukraine. An immediate employment and business support is needed, which includes increasing ability of local micro, small and medium entrepreneurs to move their activity and sales online.

For this purpose, UN RPP is seeking a legal entity that will provide a series of remote training sessions on online product promotion and sales.

#### II. MAIN OBJECTIVES OF THE ASSIGNMENT

The overall objective of this assignment is to boost the capacity of MSMEs from Luhansk, Donetsk and selected rayons of Zaporizhzhia oblasts in their efforts to cope with COVID-19-related changes in the market environment, and to enhance their ability to promote and distribute their products using online channels and to limit disruption to essential commerce during the pandemic. For this purpose, the Contractor shall develop and deliver 5 remote training sessions on online product promotion and sales.

The training shall contribute to the achievement of the following learning objectives:

**Objective 1.** At least 250 participants from the government-controlled areas in Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts and from selected rayons of Zaporizhzhia oblast (Berdiansk, Prymorsk, Pryazovia, Orikhiv, Guliaipole, Yakymivka, Bilmak rayons) have increased their knowledge of how to digitalize a business, what are the potential online sales channels, how to use them properly and what the benefits and challenges of online product promotion are;

**Objective 2.** Participants of remote training sessions improved their skills to develop new sales channels using different social media and e-commerce platforms operating and popular in Ukraine.

#### SCOPE OF WORK AND EXPECTED OUTPUTS

The Contractor shall perform the following tasks:

1. **Initial stage.** Develop 3-day remote courses (up to 4 hours a day) on online product promotion and sales, taking into account listed objectives and minimum learning outputs.

Specifically, the Contractor shall implement the following:

- Develop and approve by UN RPP an Inception Report containing a work plan and a detailed methodology including an overview of the tools and online platform(s) to be used under this assignment;
- Develop training toolkit to be shared remotely among the participants prior to training sessions containing the following elements: agenda, handbook of theoretical learning materials with a step-by-step approach to e-commerce for MSMEs described (.pdf, up to 60 pages, single spacing, Noto Sans or Arial font, size 11), multimedia presentations, practical exercises, other multimedia, information and graphics to be used during the training sessions developed. Training agendas should be based on template provided by UN RPP. The format and contents of handouts are to be agreed with UN RPP. All materials should contain UN RPP and donor logos provided by UN RPP. The Programme should be granted full rights for the produced knowledge materials;
- Design training schedule and agree it with UN RPP. Training hours during the weekend should be avoided;
- Develop a text of announcement in Ukrainian language and agree it with UN RPP. The announcement should contain overall information on the training programme, its objectives, target areas, training company and other relevant information;
- Develop online registration form for training using any of the open-source platform and agree with UN RPP.
   Editor's access to the registration form should be provided to a person designated by UN RPP;
- Develop mechanism for selection of training participants and agree with UN RPP. The mechanism should provide
  a transparent scoring system for selection of participants and the waiting list;
- Develop evaluation criteria, online pre-training survey and post-training evaluation forms to assess the achievement of the learning objectives and participants' satisfaction.

Output 1:

- An Inception Report developed, submitted and approved by UN RPP;
- Training schedule designed and approved by UN RPP;
- A text of announcement in Ukrainian language developed and agreed with UN RPP;
- Online registration form for training developed and agreed with UN RPP. Editor's access to the registration form provided to a person designated by UN RPP;
- Training toolkit, including agendas and a handbook of theoretical learning materials on e-commerce developed and agreed with UN RPP;
- A mechanism for selection of training participants developed and approved by UN RPP;
- A list of evaluation indicators and online pre/post-training self-evaluation forms developed and agreed with UN RPP.

#### The training agenda should cover but not be limited to the following topics:

- Assessing business model and ability to adopt a multichannel sales strategy and switch to e-commerce (clients and types of shopping behavior, type of product(s), brand and its positioning in the market, customer service).
- How to promote products and services? (sales promotion, consumer promotion, trade promotion, direct marketing, event marketing).
- Common national and international online sales platforms for MSMEs, their strengths and weaknesses: general marketplace (Rozetka.ua, Prom.ua, Amazon.com, etc.), auction marketplace (newAuction.com.ua, SkyLots.org, eBay.com, etc.), social media (Facebook, Instagram, Pinterest, etc.), classified listings websites (OLX.ua, etc.), comparison shopping engines (Hotline.ua, etc.), individual online stores and other channels.
- Delivery systems operating in Ukraine (Ukrposhta, Novaposhta, MeestExpress, JustIn, etc.). How to use them to do business and what are the benefits?
- MSME's payment processing system. Digital payment solutions.
- Women in e-commerce (success stories).

#### The minimum learning outputs shall be:

- Inform participant on best practices of MSMEs' response to COVID-19 challenges;
- Enable participants launch online public profiles of a business in social media and/or profiles at commonly used e-commerce platforms, and/or web pages/sites of their business;
- Provide information on door to door delivery systems operating in Ukraine, their opportunities and limitations in COVID-19 pandemic environment;
- Share information on digital payment options to be utilized in participants' business activity;
- Strengthen participants' capacity to establish effective relations with media and local influencers to improve communication of their businesses.

Estimated implementation period: up to 10 calendar days after the Contract start date

#### 2. Announcement for training on business startup and promotion, registration and selection of participants.

#### Output 2:

- Announcement of the training programme disseminated through at least 20 online media and information resources relevant for each of the targeted regions. A list of resources should be shared with UN RPP for approval prior to publishing. Rotation and re-publishing should be ensured on a daily basis during the whole registration process. A media report should be developed and submitted to UN RPP upon the closure of registration. UN RPP shall place the announcement and links to the online registration form at official UNDP resources;

- Registration launched for at least 7 calendar days for each training session;
- Continuous selection process launched in parallel with the online registration. Selection process for each separate training session should be finished no later than 3 days before the training session;
- At least 250 participants selected in total for five training sessions, and a waiting list of at least 50 people willing to participate (10 additional candidates for each training session) composed. List of participants and waiting list should be approved by UN RPP;
- A list of refused participants shared with UN RPP;
- Letters of invitation to selected participants, letters of inclusion to the waiting list and refusal letters to applicants who were not selected for participation sent off no later than 3 days before each training session. The contents of the letters should be agreed with UN RPP;
- Gender balance should be ensured;
- Interim report № 1 submitted and approved by UN RPP.

#### Eligibility criteria and requirements to applicants:

- Businesspersons (MSME owners) who reside in the GCAs of Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts. Residents of local communities, as well as IDPs who live in the target areas are invited to apply;
- Businesspersons (MSME owners) in following rayons of Zaporizhzhia oblast: Berdiansk, Prymorsk, Pryazovia,
  Orikhiv, Guliaipole, Yakymivka, Bilmak. Residents of local communities, as well as IDPs who live in the target
  areas are invited to apply;
- Applicants should briefly describe consequences of COVID-19 pandemic for their business and express their
  willingness to promote and sell products via different online channels and duly indicate this in their application
  forms;
- Applicants may submit only one application and participate only in one training;
- Equal participation of women and men should be promoted.

Estimated implementation period: up to 30 calendar days after the Contract start date

#### 3. Training Delivery.

- Deliver five (5) 3-day remote training sessions to at least 250 selected citizens (up to 4 hours a day, about 50 participants for each session) of target communities and IDPs who reside in these communities using the widely-used interactive platforms for online training and webinars with good quality of sound and video recording free for participants and approved by UN RPP;
- Conduct a pre-training survey and post-training evaluation for 100% trainees using online forms approved by UN RPP. Electronic versions of all the forms should be provided to UN RPP;

#### Output 3:

- 5 (five) 3-day training (with at least 50 participants each) delivered remotely;
- At least 250 participants from targeted communities attended the training as per the participant list;
- Participant lists sent to UN RPP within 1-day period after the end of each training;
- Information and handout materials duly distributed among participants;
- Interim report № 2 submitted and approved by UN RPP.

Estimated implementation period: up to 55 calendar days after the Contract start date.

Requirements to the team of trainers and training conditions:

- A sufficient number of qualified trainers should be provided. It is expected that at least 1 training will be held simultaneously with no more than 2-day break between the training sessions;
- A team leader should be assigned to coordinate overall project performance and act as a single person in charge of all project-related issues and communications with UN RPP;
- A project assistant should be assigned to coordinate administrative aspects and communicate with trainees;
- Roles of the team leader and project assistant can be combined, though this should not influence neither the scope of works for each separate position, nor the execution timeframes;
- The information materials and presentations should address the needs of the target audience and include quality visualization, graphics, be clear and easy to perceive. All materials should contain proper visibility of UN RPP and donors provided by UN RPP;
- The number of participants of each training should not be less than 50 people.

#### 5. Final stage.

#### Output 5:

Final report submitted and accepted by UN RPP, containing but not limited to following:

- training toolkit containing the following elements: handbook of theoretical learning materials with a step-by-step approach to e-commerce for MSMEs described (.pdf, up to 60 pages, single spacing, Noto Sans or Arial font, size 11), multimedia presentations, practical exercises;
- processed information on participants containing data disaggregated by gender, age and territory;
- summary and analysis of pre-training and post-training evaluation addressing participants' initial knowledge and endof-training satisfaction with the training content;
- summary of participants' insights on the training;
- recommendations for further actions in the target regions;
- text summary of each 5 courses designed in pdf (with all relevant links and names of documents inserted);
- video record of each 5 courses with necessary editing (to cut any video or sound interruptions to ensure a good quality recorded material).

Estimated implementation period: up to 60 calendar days after the Contract start date

# IV. MONITORING/REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor shall submit the following reports according to UN RPP format and guidelines. The format of reports shall be agreed at the first stage of the contract implementation programme, but UN RPP reserves the right to make further changes and clarifications in the report form.

#### Types of reports:

- 1) Inception and interim reports submitted in Ukrainian, including reports on the work accomplished, results, monitoring, and financial indicators:
- Inception report 15 calendar days after the Contract starting date;
- Interim report No. 1-30 calendar days after the Contract starting date;
- Interim report No. 2 55 calendar days after the Contract starting date;
- Interim report No. 3 60 calendar days after the Contract starting date.

- 2) Weekly operational email reports on current results, implementation and issues of the training programme;
- 3) Brief reports periodically submitted upon request of UN RPP in cases where it is required to get information on the progress of the programme in between reporting periods;
- 4) Final narrative report including a description of activities and results, lessons learned and conclusions reflecting the whole period of contract no later than 60 calendar days after the Contract starting date. The report (up to 30 pages, single spacing, Noto Sans or Arial font, size 11) should be submitted in Ukrainian language with a summary (up to 10 pages, single spacing, Noto Sans or Arial font, size 11) in English language. Data should be disaggregated by, gender, age groups and other categories as required by UN RPP.

All reports and survey results UN RPP shall be transmitted electronically (Formats of: \* .docx, \* .xlsx, \* .pptx, \* .pdf) on electronic source or in the form of electronic communication with the attached final product, which is also accompanied by an official letter of the Contractor/Implementer about the data transmission of products to the UNDP.

The Contractor shall comply with the system of monitoring, evaluation and quality control introduced by UN RPP, and also provide the necessary information, reports and statistical data according to the predetermined schedule *or* as soon as possible (within a reasonable time).

The inception report, interim reports and the final report shall follow the pre-set template agreed with UN RPP that includes both substantial and financial parts and shall be shared with the respective official.

As a quality assurance measure, UN RPP reserves the right to initiate online spot-checks at trainings, to conduct remote interviews with participants and receive feedback on the quality of the Contractor's work. The Contractor shall facilitate the process by presenting UN RPP with all necessary contacts of the trainees and shall refrain from influencing the impartiality of the assessment procedures.

- Bachelor's (or higher) degree followed by at least 5 years of relevant experience in the field of business and entrepreneurship training development and delivery;


