1	Depending on the budget and the desired scope, the approach to the proposal would vary enormously. It would be extremely helpful to have some indication as to estimated person days and/or financial limit of the proposal.	This is request for proposal procurement process and each company should submit their financial proposal based on methodology and technical proposal submitted.
2	Could you elaborate a bit more on the target group (e.g. educational level, age group, focus countries in the Arab Region, diversity and inclusion)?	Youth between the ages of 18-29. We work with youth and youth serving organizations in most of the Arab countries except Oman, Mauritania.
3	When you talk about the course/programme, can you give more details as to:	We would like to create a curriculum for trainers (who train youth) and youth on Climate Change in the Arab Region so that they understand the impact and raise their knowledge and awareness. We would also like to ensure that youth's social innovations (solutions to problems in their country) are environmentally friendly, therefore a tool will need to be created for them to use. You should create a guide for the trainer, with resources and a guide for youth with resources and tools.

3.2	What length and/or number of credits do you envisage?	Not accredited.
