1	Q	Should we combine the mitigation and adaptation in one document or separated?
	A	<p>The Low Carbon Development Initiative (LCDI) in Indonesia was initiated by The Directorate of Environmental Affairs, Bappenas to incorporate the carbon emission reduction targets and carrying capacity into a development planning framework that will shape the economic and social trajectories.</p> <p>The LCDI platform and/or framework will not only focus on how to reduce the emission but also see and analyze the socio and environmental risk and impact to the economic growth and development planning.</p> <p>Climate change mitigation action become the biggest and major issue inside the LCDI concept and framework. The six LCDI sectors are energy, forestry, agriculture, industry, waste, and blue carbon (marine+coastal area covered mangrove area).</p> <p>It is possible to see the climate change adaptation action inside the LCDI approach but it is less than the mitigation action. For example in the agriculture sector, there is an improvement of land productivity. It can be seen as an adaptation action but mostly this activity will be recorded as a mitigation action as it will give a major contribution to emission reduction targets in the agriculture sector. LCDI approach is possible to give a double impact both in mitigation and adaptation but since the LCDI approach using the mitigation point of view, you may please separate and more focus on the mitigation action regarding the enhancement on generic LCDI macro model for the west and central java provinces. If you would like to add an adaptation action, you may please to do that to enrich the assessment.</p>
