If the supplier does not accept the final price based on UNDP's re-computation and correction of errors, its quotation will be rejected.

After UNDP has identified the lowest price offer, UNDP reserves the right to award the contract based only on the prices of the goods in the event that the transportation cost (freight and insurance) is



STRENGTHENING THE NATIONAL PROTECTED AREAS SYSTEMS OF ESWATINI (SNPAS) PROJECT

Terms of Reference

Title:	Rehabilitate Mantenga Nature Reserve Road network
Country of Assignment:	Eswatini
Starting Date:	31 st August 2020
Duration of Assignment:	66 days

Background

Mantenga has an access road of approximately 2km, which stretches from the main gate to the Waterfall parking lot. Currently the access road is in a bad state due to poor drainage and rainfalls continue to degrade the road surface. The road network has potholes and gullies, which makes it inaccessible to low ground clearance vehicles. The current condition of the roads has a negative impact to park visitors, hence the park has prioritized the rehabilitation of the tourists' road network. The ENTC proposes to refurbish and rehabilitate the park access road to probase standard.

Job Description

ENTC invites national companies with capacity to bid for the supply of hired heavy plant machinery to rehabilitate Mantenga Nature Reserve access road to probase standard. The ENTC proposes to refurbish and rehabilitate the park access road by applying gravel on the damaged surface area, opening drainage lines, opening culvert and erecting humps along the road network. The goal is strengthening of PA eco-tourism through improvement and development of road infrastructure in order to improve PA revenue generation and sustainability.

Objectives

The project objective is to effectively expand, manage and develop Eswatini's protected area network in order to adequately protect the biodiversity and landscapes of the country. This activity contributes to the objective of strengthening PA eco-tourism through supporting the rehabilitation of eco-tourism infrastructure.

Scope Of Work

ENTC is looking for a company who has the capacity to bid for construction road at Mantenga Nature Reserve. The access road to be constructed required must be in good condition and be of high quality standard. The work entails installation of road signs, drainage systems, and an all-weather surface.
