1.	Q	How deep you would like get the analysis especially for Human Resources due to wide range of organizations, staff and offices?
	A	We are not going so deep into particular function but would like to get strategic overview of the personnel working on data, not necessarily all staffs.
2.	Q	In the Timeline, Payment and Deliverables table (under "Payment Term 3") you reference a "Chapter 4" of the Data Strategy, but in the "Standard of Final Report" outline you refer to only 3 Chapters. Which is correct (and, if it is four chapters, can we please know the content for Chapter 4)?
	A	Basically, you need to focus situational/landscape analysis on the data, mapping of capacity and the write up of the entire Data Strategy as required in the list of deliverables on the ToR.
3.	Q	Both key personnel qualifications stated must have education degree in Data Management but did not require that they have experience in Data Management
	A	We are not focusing only in Data management but also in political economy
