1	Deliverable 2: What do you exactly mean by "preparation of the data driven content to be fed into the dashboard"?	Aggregated findings based on the "big data + machine learning" process will be prepared by the research team and shared with the data visualization experts. The experts, under Deliverable 2, should also advise on whether they would need the data to be aggregated in a specific manner and be able to review the findings and advise on visualization based on these findings. For the static infographics, for example, the data visualization experts, should suggest what narrative/story to highlight, which will be eventually decided on together with input from UNDP research team.
2	Deliverable 4: How long should be the three training seminars on data visualization and storytelling?	Each seminar should run over 2 full days or 4 half-days. The total of the 3 seminars should run over 6 full days or 12 half-days.
3	Deliverable 5 and 6: Can you provide more info about what you mean by "data gaps" and the type of data that will be part of these 2 deliverables?	The information on data gaps will be prepared by the UNDP team. It will be based on the SDGs global indicator framework and a methodology that UNDP puts together to assess the extent to which countries have been producing and publishing SDGs-relevant data. For example, the visualization would provide aggregated analysis of ability of Lebanon to report on 100 indicators, so data gap might result in showing that Lebanon can only report on 30/100 indicators. Again, the information is prepared by UNDP team. Data visualization expert should advise on wireframes, functionality of dashboard (which variables would appear where) and how "data gaps" will be visualized (what form to emphasize gaps, shortage of data, etc.).
