ATTACHMENT-1 ANSWERS TO OUESTIONS FROM PROSPECTIVE PROPOSERS

QUESTION 1:

In the RFP document under "Minimum Eligibility and Qualification Criteria" section, it is stated that "The proposer must have successfully completed as contractor at least 1 (one) planning, conducting and implementing trainings in cooperation with local economic actors (chambers, business associations, industrial zones, technoparks) or governmental institutions or enterprise within the last 5 years with a minimum contract amount of 250,000.00 TRY. (Work completion certificates issued by the contracting authority shall be provided for the references to meet qualification criterion)". Could you please kindly inform me if the minimum contract amount is under a single contract? In other words, will the total amount of budget spent for mentioned activities during the reference period be considered as one experience?

ANSWER 1:

The proposer must have successfully completed as contractor <u>at least 1 (one) single contract</u> which includes all the stipulated activities and requirements.

QUESTION 2:

In the RFP document under "Criteria for the Assessment of Proposal" section it is stated that 'Original or notarized copy of Trade Registers Gazette' is required. As the proposal will be submitted online, we assume that all legal company documents copies will be sufficient and no hard copy delivery of these documents is necessary. Could you please confirm it?

ANSWER 2:

The proposer shall provide scanned or digital copy of these documents stated under "Criteria for the Assessment of Proposal" section of the RFP within the proposal. Proposal must be submitted in the online e-tendering system. Original hardcopy documents may be requested by UNDP and shall be presented when requested.

QUESTION 3:

Is it possible to propose the same personnel in more than one proposal submitted for this RFP, by different companies?

ANSWER 3:

It <u>is not</u> possible to propose the same personnel in more than one proposal submitted for this RFP, by different companies. If same personnel is proposed in more than one proposal received for this RFP process, all proposals including the same personnel shall be <u>rejected</u>.
