2. Project Description

UN Resident Coordinator Office in Cambodia together with OHCHR and UN-Habitat have proposed a project called "Sihanoukville for All: Promoting a Smart, Sustainable and Inclusive City" which should be implemented from August 2020 to July 20201.

The overall purpose of this project is to conduct a comprehensive assessment, in line with the United Nations Human Security approach and Cambodia's United Nations Development Assistance Framework (UNDAF), and propose policy and programmatic solutions for the United Nations Country Team (UNCT) and national authorities to capitalise on the surge of investments and improve the living standards of the Cambodian population, including vulnerable groups, in Preah Sihanouk province. The assessment will be implemented through a partnership between the UNCT, led by OHCHR and UN-Habitat with support of the UN Resident Coordinator's Office, and the Royal Government of Cambodia in consultation with the private sector, local communities, civil society and selected research institutions.

The comprehensive, people-centered, context-specific and prevention-oriented assessment will be designed to identify challenges and opportunities in Preah Sihanouk province and provide local and national authorities and other relevant stakeholders with evidence and analytics to define risk informed strategies, programmes and policy options. This aims to promote the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the Royal Government of Cambodia's vision to make Sihanoukville a smart, sustainable and inclusive city, and address socio-economic issues faced by local population, particularly the most vulnerable groups.

There are three outputs proposed under this project:

- 1.1. A standing inclusive consultation process for all relevant stakeholders is established to discuss the impact and opportunities of rapidly growing economy in Preah Sihanouk province;
- 1.2. The concept of "Sustainable, Inclusive and Smart SHV city" is defined and codified through inclusive and participatory stakeholder consultations and expert advisory service;
- 1.3. A comprehensive, evidence-based and participatory analysis identifies challenges to human security, their causes, and opportunities, and provides local and national authorities with evidence, analytics and ideas to define risk informed strategies, programmes and policy options.

For ensuring effective and efficient project implementation, UN-Habitat Cambodia Office is seeking for one qualified national consultant to facilitate and coordinate the project implementation and provide input to the development of the project outputs above. He or she will be based at UN-Habitat Office in Phnom Penh and travel to Sihanoukville if necessary. An international consultant is also recruited as part of the team to assist the project implementation. The contract will be for 8 months (part-time- 01 Dec 2020 – 31 July 2021).

3. Scope of Work

During the project implementation, the individual contractor is expected to participate in all activities listed in the project document and produce the expected outputs. The Individual contractor will work in close coordination and following instructions of relevant colleagues within the UN-Habitat, OHCHR and RCO Cambodia. The individual contractor will work closely with International Consultant to formulate the smart city framework and case study for the project as well as to contribute technically to project outputs above.

4. Expected Outputs and Deliverables

Under the direct guidance of the RCO, UN-Habitat and OHCHR in Cambodia, the contractor will be responsible of the following:

Project Coordination

- Coordinate the UN implementing agencies (UN-Habitat and OHCHR), other UN agencies, Preah Sihanouk provincial counterpart, other stakeholders and development partners;
- Work in close partnership with the Peace and Development Team at the RCO, OHCHR and UN-Habitat to support the UN Resident Coordinator to coordinate wholly the implementation of the project on behalf of the UNCT in partnership with the Cambodian Government, Provincial authorities and civil society counterparts, as well as other development partners;
- Support the coordination and participation related to official travels for meetings in Preah Sihanouk province, upon invitations by the Chair of the Smart City provincial working group, and other travels if necessary;
- Work in close cooperation and good coordination with the selected teams of consultants commissioned by OHCHR and UN Habitat working for this project;

Work Planning and Reporting

- Coordinate with Smart city task team and 3i/Australia Aid, OHCHR and UN-Habitat to come up with agreed workplan and facilitate the regular meeting when needed;
- Prepare progress activity report on the implementation of the project in close cooperation with the RCO's Peace and Development Team, OHCHR and UN-Habitat;
- Provide inputs and oversee the implementation of the project activities at Sihanoukville when requires;
- Facilitate and report the project progress to Urban task team of UNDAF Outcome on managing urbanization and other UNDAF outcomes when needed;
- Facilitating efficient project implementation in close collaboration with UN agencies, donors and the Cambodian government
- Facilitating efficient project implementation in liaise with partners, stakeholders and beneficiaries
- Assisting development of progress reports and financial reports as per the agreements with the project donor
- Contributing to resource mobilization and formulation of concept notes/ proposals within related fields to this project
- Performing other relevant tasks including workshops/training organization as necessary and required by the project team.
