Goods offered shall be reviewed based on completeness and compliance of the quotation with the minimum specifications described above and any other annexes providing details of UNDP requirements. The quotation that complies with all of the specifications, requirements and offers the lowest price, as well as all other evaluation criteria indicated, shall be selected. Any offer that does not meet the requirements shall be rejected.

Any discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity) shall be re-computed by UNDP. The unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected. If the supplier does not accept the final price based on UNDP's re-computation and correction of errors, its quotation will be rejected.

Technical Specifications for backup power supply generator.

UN House located in 14 P. Adamyan str., Yerevan city, Armenia. In the territory of the UN House should be installed backup power generator in order to ensure uninterrupted power supply of the UN House.

Main working conditions:

Average temperature deviation during the year is -25°C +35°C

Altitude over the sea level is 950m

Average humidity is 30%-60%

Requirements and specifications:

Brand new, diesel generator. Produced in 2020.

Generator output rating:

Standby – min 200 kVA, 50Hz, 3 phases

Remote control

With engine water heater

Automatic battery charger

Fuel tank Capacity: not less 500L

Engine Speed: 1500 RPM

Fuel Consumption at 75 % Load, max 37 l/h

Generator should have the separate block of the automatic transfer switch, with phase sequence control, possible programming all parameters and adjusted voltage limit 400V, +/-20%

Generator should be with outside installation

Silent

Sound Pressure Level at 7m 75%Load not more than 73dB

Generator Set Standards

The equipment meets the following standards: BS5000, ISO 8528, ISO 3046, IEC 60034, NEMA MG-1.22.

Level 2 enclosure reduces sound levels to comply with the stage 2 levels of the European Community Directive 2000/14/EC.

Warranty

Minimum – 2 years for standby application.

Installation and commissioning

The vendor should implement proper installation and commissioning including new cabling(40meters) from generator to separate block of the automatic transfer switch

The vendor should provide all necessary consumables which should be replaced by provided generator manual during 2 years (filters etc.)
