Pre-amble:

Mr. Ehsanul Karim Chowdhury from the UNDP country office's procurement unit highlighted the process and compliances for proposal submission. He has also explained the following procedure a) how to register in UNDP e-Tendering system, and b) how to Submit a Bid on e-Tendering also outline of Technical and Financial proposal submission process.

Ms. Jhuma Dewan briefed on Terms of Reference, the works' scope, and project background.

Mr. Shefatul Islam of the A2i Project clarified the collaboration of two projects. He also touched upon some of the technical requirements of the assignment.

The participants were then allowed to ask questions for further clarification about the assignment and proposal submission process. Following were the questions asked in the meeting and received through BD Procurement and their answers.

These participants are mainly District and Upazila Eductaion Officers and teachers of Junior and High schools in the CHT from various Upazilas.

Bangla is used for general communications but there are major issues of commuciations gaps beween ethnic groups. In primary, junior and high schools Bangla is the medium of teaching. Hence, the content of the digital training module has to be in Bangla for ensuring effectiveness.
