S/L	Queries	UNDP Response
1.	01 day briefing to enumerators for this specific survey will not be enough. Can this briefing period to enumerators be for 03 days?	01 day training will be provided virtually by UNDP to the team lead and supervisors, who can then train the field enumerators for another two days or as required. Researchers from UNDP will be present (in person or virtually) during the enumerators training. But this is subject to changes depending on the situation to ensure collection of quality data.
2.	Can the list of villages be shared with the firm for ease of cost calculation?	The list of villages will be provided to the selected firm during the briefing meeting.
3.	If the beneficiary list for survey can be shared with bidder now?	The list of beneficiaries will be provided to the selected firm during the briefing meeting.
