# Provision of Workforce and Staffing Services for UNDP-SPOI/Good Growth Partnership (GGP) Programme

#### I. BACKGROUND

The rapid growth of palm oil production globally has largely come at the expense of forested areas. Indonesia, as one of the world's largest producers of palm oil, has received much attention in recent years particularly from the global community concerning the sustainability of its palm oil production. For example, oil palm expansion caused one-quarter of all deforestation in Indonesia between 2009 and 2011 (Greenpeace 2013). Fifty-six per cent of the oil palm plantations in Indonesia have replaced forests (Koh & Wilcove 2008), most significantly in the provinces of North Sumatra, Riau and Jambi, and the south-western borders of Kalimantan (Romijin et al. 2013). Continued deforestation adds significant environmental pressures on ecologically sensitive areas, with extensive impacts on biodiversity, habitat fragmentation, land degradation and soil erosion.

To address the concern of the international community, the Government of Indonesia (GoI) has taken steps towards building a greener economy that promotes growth, equity, improved livelihood and environmental integrity including in the palm oil sector. Aiming to support the government's actions, UNDP has been working together with the Indonesian Ministry of Agriculture to achieve the country's goals of sustainable palm oil production through the **Sustainable Palm Oil Initiative (SPOI)**. The objective of the project is to promote the sustainable production and use of palm oil by (i) assisting smallholders to produce palm oil sustainably and (ii) strengthening the Indonesia Sustainable Palm Oil (ISPO) scheme while minimizing adverse environmental and social impacts. The project will improve the sustainability of the Indonesian palm oil sector, by working with the Indonesian government and focusing on four key components or work streams. This includes:

- 1)Support smallholder farmers via the creation of sustainable farmers support systems that will enhance their engagement, their organization and governance (through Farmers Groups) and their adoption of good agricultural practices;
- 2)Enhance dialogues, build consensus and reduce conflict related to palm oil production, and create more effective policy enabling environments;
- 3)Collaborate with the government to improve environmental monitoring and management; and 4)Strengthen the national palm oil ISPO standard and increase market access.

In 2017, the SPOI received additional funding to work on activities that contribute to the above work streams. The funding comes from the Global Environment Facility (GEF) through a project named Reducing Deforestation from Commodity Production under a programme umbrella – Good Growth Partnership (GGP).

To support the Gol's efforts to pursue sustainable palm oil development, the SPOI will implement several pilot activities that will contribute to the National Action Plan (NAP) implementation. These work streams comprise of: (1) Smallholder Support Strategies for Government and Smallholder Capacity Building, (2) Environment Management and Monitoring, (3) Dialogues, consensus and policy strengthening, (4) ISPO and market access.

In implementation at the site level, UNDP has supported the Government in all mentioned areas by providing technical assistance and support through its staff and contracting companies to provide technical services and support as part of institutional building. However, concerning the COVID 19 situation in Indonesia and the temporary official travel ban by UNDP, UNDP seeks to hire several field staff that could carry out routine work and ensure that all activities in the field can be coordinated and carried out properly. Furthermore, to ensure the professionalism of work, team management, and health protocol for all people involved in the project, UNDP plans to hire a third party to provide professional staff.

Especially in Pelalawan, UNDP seeks to hire a service provider to provide a safe office space to support project activities.

#### II. PURPOSE

The overall purpose and objective of this RFQ are to provide competent and professional personnel, including all provisions that comply with the labor law and regulations in Indonesia, which will assist UNDP and its partners in implementing sustainable palm oil activities in **Pelalawan**, **Riau**.

In order to contribute to this objective, THE FIRM will provide:

a.4 (four) Field Service Assistants for the period of 9 (nine) months from April 2021 to December 2021, who will be based

in Pelalawan;

b.1 (one) Senior Smallholder Specialist for the period of 8 (eight) months from May 2021 to December 2021, who will be

based in Pelalawan;

Furthermore, specifically for smallholder training support program, THE FIRM is also required to perform payment for current office space rental fee in Sorek Satu, Pelalawan for 8 (eight) months (May 2021 to December 2021). The building rental in Sorek Satu is for 13 persons (5 persons of Field Team, 5 persons for demo-plot smallholders and 3 Pelalawan Plantation Office representative. The standard of total space for one person is approximately 10m2 (refer to: https://peraturan.bkpm.go.id/jdih/userfiles/batang/Pepres\_73\_2011.pdf). Therefore the minimum space required to accommodate 13 persons is 130 m2.

#### III. SCOPE OF WORK

THE FIRM will help UNDP increase visibility and process efficiencies, stabilize work outcomes and optimize business results in locating the right candidate. THE FIRM should possess the ability to source professionals for the level specified in the ToRs for the respective personnel. The scope will start from finding talented, well qualified people in each respective place. Additionally, the personnel will work with UNDP thru THE FIRM contracts. Nevertheless, THE FIRM will put higher priority, where appropriate, for the candidates recommended by UNDP, with clear justification from UNDP.

THE FIRM shall conduct searches for qualified candidates for positions required by UNDP, specified in the terms of reference. Searches shall include a wide range of specialty practices including, but not limited to, advanced technology, education/ not-for-profit/associations, financial services, healthcare products, healthcare provider/ managed care and professional services.

THE FIRM will outsource the personnel to UNDP at a full-time basis. The selected personnel will be required to submit monthly work-plan for their activities to be reviewed and approved by UNDP's project managers and/or coordinators. There will be separate individual contract for each personnel hired by THE FIRM for UNDP. The UNDP will pay THE FIRM for deliverable rendered and accepted by UNDP. THE FIRM has obligation to pay the personnel and comply with Government of Indonesia rules and regulation.

Actions required in the process include, but are not limited to:

A. Identify Qualified Candidates based on the Terms of Refences provided by UNDP for respective positions. THE FIRM shall use their resources to undertake intensive search to find candidates whose qualifications match the position requirements on the Position Specification. The shortlisted candidates should be 10 personnel at the minimum in order to allow UNDP to have options and select the best candidates. THE FIRM shall acknowledge that UNDP Indonesia reserve the right to select the personnel. UNDP is committed to achieving workforce diversity in terms of gender, nationality and culture. Individuals from minority groups, indigenous groups and persons with disabilities are equally considered.

**B. Submit the personnel proposal.** THE FIRM will qualify candidates by resume review to obtain a thorough understanding of their accomplishments, capabilities, and potential. A comprehensive CV describing past work experiences and education; technical proposal; and required supporting document will be presented to UNDP on each candidate whom Contractor recommends.

**C. Conduct Reference Checks on Successful Candidates.** THE FIRM shall verify education, work experience, professional licenses and certifications, and, if necessary, professional references prior to the interview process, as requested by UNDP. Contractor shall present summary of findings to UNDP. For the sake of confidentiality, reference checks will only be performed on those candidates who UNDP determines are of strong interest.

**D. Hiring and managing the candidate and outsource as personnel to UNDP**. THE FIRM shall hire the personnel for position and will outsource the personnel to UNDP as full-time individual personnel who will work based on the roles and responsibilities as specified in their ToRs for the positions, as well as the agreed work-plan. THE FIRM shall assist in the negotiation of offer in consultation with UNDP with the preferred candidate and has obligation to pay the personnel and comply with Government of Indonesia rules and regulation on manpower.

**E. Perform payment for the smallholder's training related cost and building rental in Sorek Satu, Pelalawan.** THE FIRM shall provide an office space for the field representatives' and perform the necessary payment (all inclusive of water, electricity, internet bill, cleaning service). The total area of office space is 130 m2 at the minimum in order to accommodate 5 field team members, 5 demo-plot farmers as well as Pelalawan Plantation Office representatives who may come and hold meeting at the office space.
