ATTACHMENT 1- ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS FROM PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

Question 1: It has been observed that "Joint Venture/Consortium" is not allowed within the scope of subject RFQ. However, I would like to learn if we can use the experience of another company which we own 90% of its shares?

Answer 1: Kindly note that as clearly stated in Previous Experience Article (pg. 4) of the RFQ, the Bidder must have successfully completed, <u>as the prime contractor</u>, minimum one civil works contract of similar nature (i.e. construction of any kind of buildings) at minimum contract amount of USD 100,000 over the last three years counting back from the bid submission deadline in order to be considered qualified. In addition, as clearly stated in Section 1: A brief description of your qualification and capacity that is relevant to the Scope of Works (pg. 106) under ANNEX 3: TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL OFFER of the RFQ, only those assignments for which the Bidder was legally contracted by the Client as a company or was one of the Consortium/JV partners should be listed. Assignments completed by the Bidder's individual experts working privately or through other firms cannot be claimed as the relevant experience of the Bidder, or that of the Bidder's partners or sub-consultants, but can be claimed by the Experts themselves in their CVs. In other words, the assignments completed through Bidder's other companies <u>cannot</u> be claimed as the relevant experience of the Bidder.
