Background

The Ministry of Environment and Physical Planning (MoEPP) has submitted its Nationally Determined Contributions under the Paris Agreement of the UNFCCC, supported by the UNDP Climate Promise Initiative. The waste sector is the second largest source of greenhouse gases in North Macedonia.

Biowaste and Construction and demolition (C&D) streams are one of the largest in the country, both by weight and volume. Due to the high potential for recycling and reuse of both waste streams they have been identified as a priority waste streams in the "Macedonian rapid assessment report on the benefits of circular economy on mitigation of GHGs emission in the waste sector", supported by the project. Circular practices for C&D and biowaste provide more than 70% of the emission savings, almost 20 million EUR per year of economic benefits (about 45% of the total benefits) and almost ¼ of the new jobs expected. But introduction of circular practices for both streams faces significant challenges that need to be addressed with significant investments and systemic solution. UNDP is supporting the Macedonian Government in green post-Covid recovery and development of proposal that enables creation of new green jobs shall significantly contribute to these efforts.

Therefore, UNDP would like to engage national consultant to support preparation of a project proposal in the area of circular economy for a new Ambition Initiative Call for NAMA Support Projects that seek to reduce GHG emissions while enhancing the ambition of the country's Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) to the Paris Agreement.

Therefore, a Company/Institution will be contracted with the aim to develop a project proposal in the area of circular economy (biowaste and construction & demolition waste).

Scope of work:

The objective of the assignment is to support preparation of a circular economy project proposal for a new Ambition Initiative Call for NAMA Support Projects, utilizing the findings and recommendation of the

The company shall work closely with national consultant engaged for this assignment, as well as the Ministry of Environment and Physical Planning.

Duties and responsibilities

Under the supervision of the UNDP Programme Officer and in close cooperation with the Ministry of Environment and Physical Planning and other relevant consultants engaged by the project, the contractor shall be responsible for delivering project proposal for the NAMA Facility, that has put forward a new Ambition Initiative Call for NAMA Support Projects that seek to reduce GHG emissions while enhancing the ambition of the country's Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) to the Paris Agreement.

- Engage waste industry practitioners, local commercial banks, and the Development Bank to conceptualize a financial mechanism that can overcome the identified financial barriers to investment in circular economy projects;
- Support development of an excel analysis of mitigation potential given specific interventions and clearly stating the relevant methodology and assumptions;
- Support development of an Excel analysis of the financial feasibility of circular economy projects in organic waste and C&D waste given local markets and circumstances;
- Develop project proposal for the NAMA Facility, as per the requirements of the new Ambition Initiative Call for NAMA Support Projects.
