Opening remarks	Mr. Ali Saeed (PU) opened the meeting and welcomed the participants. He briefed the participants on ITB of Retrofitting of Model Structures.	
Introduction of the Project	Mr. Naeem Iqbal (NPM) proceeded with welcoming the participants and briefed them about the project activities being implementing especially the scope of the retrofitting schemes. Site visit

Few participants expressed their interest to visit proposed sites before preparing and submitting bids.

Mr. Ali Saeed moderated the Q&A session and all the queried were addressed appropriately. The details of queries and responses are as follows.

Questions and answers

Q.1: Is there any work included of Electrical and Plumbing in the scope of work?

UNDP team responded that the details related to electrical and plumbing work is added in the scope of work. It is clearly mentioned in Bill of Quantities as Electrical works, and Public health works including installation of water tanks, pumps and related items which involve plumbing works as well.

Q.2: Is there any preliminary survey of these sites conducted?

UNDP team replied that the preliminary survey and technical assessment including Nondestructive testing and structural analysis of the existing structure has been carried out by design and supervision consultant firm. BOQ's and Drawings have prepared based on the assessment.

Q3: Is registration on UNGM mandatory for this bid submission?

Registration of UNGM is not mandatory for this ITB. However, the bidder is advised to register them on UNGM as well.

Q4: What will be payment schedule? Will UNDP pay any advance payment or mobilization cost?

Advance payment is not allowed under this ITB. Therefore, the payment shall be made to the contractor against running bill of executed works through submission of Interim payment Certificate (IPC) with supporting documents dually verified by the Construction supervision consultant firm and the UNDP project Civil Engineer.

The Performance Security will be required as 10% of total contract value in form of Bang Guarantee.

A Tentative payment schedule is also uploaded with the Event attachments.

Q.5: Tax Deduction rules of UNDP.

Closing remarks

No Tax deduction will be made by UNDP. The selected bidder(s) will be responsible for submission of tax returns through respective tax jurisdiction, if any.

Q.6: Is submission of 3 contracts compulsory for the bid submission?

Yes, it is mandatory to provide 3 contracts as mentioned in ITB document.

Q.7: What will be the size and gauge of the wire mesh used for retrofitting purpose?

14 Gauge wire mesh shall be used with specified openings; however, the method of fixing was explained by consultant's team leader. The quality of the wire mesh needs to be approved by the Engineer through providing samples before its installation.

Q.8: Missing design of Rehri Goth School

The said design of the school will be uploaded in the e-tendering system.

Q.9: Quantity of Electrical and Plumber work was missing at some places which needs to be added in BOQs.

As per standard practice, few items have been added to the BOQ's. Whereas the BOQs which does not reflect the quantity of any specific item is not included in the cost estimates and shall be considered as zero. The bidder does not require to fill out rates against those items where quantities are not mentioned.

Mr. Ali Saeed closed the session by thanking the participants.

Note: Revised Bid Submission Forms

In ITB, Form-D, Eligibility & qualification form was missing. Therefore, the sequence and reference number of forms is corrected, and all Bid Submission Forms are attached with Event attachments. The bidders are required to download and submit the bid using revised forms.
