





CALL FOR PROJECT PROPOSALS

GEF SGP 7th Operational Phase

The Global Environment Facility (GEF) Small Grants Programme (SGP) provides non-governmental and community-based organizations (NGOs/CBOs) with grants, ranging from USD 5,000 to 50,000 to enable them to tackle global environmental challenges¹ while addressing local sustainable development needs. SGP is a GEF corporate programme, implemented by UNDP and executed by UNOPS. SGP Suriname started financing projects in 1997. Since then, it has succeeded in funding and providing technical support for more than 100 grant projects.

The 7th Operational Phase (OP7) which will be under implementation during 2021 to 2024, GEF SGP has the following aims: "to promote and support innovative, inclusive and scalable initiatives, and foster multi stakeholder partnerships at the local level to tackle global environmental issues in priority landscapes and seascapes".

GEF SGP Suriname's country strategy for the period 2021-2024, includes the following initiatives:

- Community-based conservation of threatened ecosystems and species
- Sustainable agriculture, fisheries and food security
- **Chemicals- and Waste management Coalition**

Eligible Organization must ensure their proposed ideas are aligned to the GEF SGP Operational Phase 7 Country Programme Strategy.

The closing date for submission of completed project proposals is June 30, 2021.
