1. BACKGROUND

The objective of the project is to promote private sector investment in renewable energy sources in Kazakhstan to achieve the country's 2030 and 2050 renewable energy targets. The project targets both large-scale and small-scale renewable energy sources.

The goal of this project is to achieve transformation of the energy market in Kazakhstan by significantly increasing the scale of the use of renewable energy sources in electricity production, thereby increasing the share of renewable energy in the country's power generation mix from 1.1% in 2017 to 10% by 2030.

To achieve its objective, the project includes activities to support renewable energy projects that are expected to bring about a collective GHG emission reduction of at least 460,000 tonnes of CO2. In addition, by the end of the project, the project would have supported the commissioning of 9.5 MW of direct, small-scale generation of renewable energy (RES), which will produce about 500 GWh of electrical energy.

2. SCOPE OF WORK, RESPONSIBILITIES AND DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED ANALYTICAL WORK

To carry out this work, the Expert needs to perform the following tasks:

- 1) Preparation of, and approval by, the client of the proposed concept for the development of the Information Package, taking into account all further necessary activities;
- 2) Design and development of the structure and content of the Information Package, as well as the proposed presentation format, and approval of the design by the client;
- 3) Provision of information on the content block of the Information Package, including a description of each sections (e.g., description of applicable RE technologies, samples of business plans, solar insolation data, wind maps, etc.);
- 4) Preparation of the first edition of the Information Package, per the client-approved concept;
- 5) Presentation of the Information Package to the client, and the main stakeholders of the DREI Project;
- 6) In case of submitting any proposals, recommendations, and comments (after the package will be presented in accordance with the para 5, above), finalization of the Information Package;
- 7) Submission of the final version of the Information Package to the client;
- 8) Preparation and conduct of an online seminar for the target audience (e.g., representatives of the Ministry of Energy of the Republic of Kazakhstan, akimats, specialized organizations working on RE resources development and utilization, potential investors in the field of RE technology applications, financial institutions, industry experts, etc.) to present the Information Package; including the documentation of the seminar proceedings.
- 9) Based on the results of the work performed, the Contractor must provide a final report on the work done.

- Provided essay and methodology describing expert's approach to the assignment;
- At least 3 reviews or recommendations from previous clients for similar service provisions.

Competencies:

 Excellent knowledge and command of the Russian language. Knowledge of English will be an advantage.

- a) Other documents certifying the work experience, expertise, education, and skills (qualification improvement certificates\diplomas, awards, etc.)

5. FINANCIAL PROPOSAL

This contract is in the national currency tenge with a lump sum of payments for each completed output. The quotation must include all expenses of the expert, including his daily rate, the number of working days (60 working days) to complete the tasks and any other relevant expenses for the task and necessary to obtain the above outputs.

Payment will be made after the approval of interim reports, based on the above outputs by the project manager and signing of the certificate of completion for each output by the UNDP project manager. The contract price will be fixed regardless of changes in cost components.

6. EVALUATION

Individual consultants will be evaluated based on **Combined Scoring method** – where the qualifications and methodology will be weighted a max. of 70%, and combined with the price offer which will be weighted a max of 30%:

- Step I: **Preliminary evaluation** of offers (ONLY fully and timely submitted applications with all required documentation (CV, essay, methodology, recommendation letters, Annex-IV and Annex V) would be considered for shortlisting;
- Step II: Shortlisting;
- Step III: Technical Evaluation 70%, consists of technical scoring of qualifications and experience (maximum 550 points);
- Step IV: Financial Evaluation 30%.

Step II: Shortlisting (Pass/fail)

Applications will be shortlisted and only applicants meeting the mandatory criteria:

- Higher Economics or Business Administration (or a related economics) education;
- At least 5 years of work experience in developing guidelines/instructions, information guides, and business information packages for project investors and project developers in Kazakhstan;
- Excellent knowledge and command of the Russian language.

Step III: Technical Evaluation – 70%:

UNDP will conduct a desk review to technically evaluate the shortlisted candidates.

Step IV: Financial evaluation – 30% of overall scoring; weight of the financial proposal will be calculated according to formula:

Lowest priced proposal /price of the proposal being evaluated *100%

The award of the contract shall be made to the individual consultant whose offer has been evaluated and determined as (a) responsive/compliant/acceptable and (b) having the highest score out of the set of weighted criteria: technical (70%) and financial (30%).
