Proceedings:

Mr. Manikandan Srinivasan from Procurement Unit, UNDP welcomed the representatives of the participating agencies.

The pre-proposal conference started with a brief round of introduction by the UNDP and the representative of participating agencies. Following introduction, Sneha Pathak, Youth Co: Lab Head provided an overview of the scope under the RFP. Subsequently, the bidders present raised various technical and commercial queries and UNDP's team provided responses.

Things to remember while summiting the bid:

- 1. Go through the UNDP user guide for bidders on UNDP website. In case of any clarification write a mail to the procurement focal point name given in the RFP document.
- 2. Try to submit your bid a day prior or well before the closing time. Do not wait until last minute. If you face any issue submitting your bid at the last minute, UNDP may not be able to assist.
- 3. Technical & Financial proposal is submitted on the letter head of the organisation and should be signed by the authorised person submitting the proposal.
- 4. Name, Email id. and contact number of the authorised person submitting the proposals should be clearly mentioned on the cover letter.
- 5. Financial proposal must be password protected; further do not disclose price anywhere on the technical proposal / e-tendering portal. Otherwise, proposal will be disqualified.

UNDP clarified that only written responses through the minutes of meeting should be considered as final. Bidders had also sought clarification by email, the clarification of which are being provided in these minutes of meeting. Participants were asked, if they face any issues with e-Tendering system, they may contact UNDP focal person mentioned in the RFP. It was also informed that the minutes of the Pre-Proposal Conference would be uploaded on the eTendering Portal.

Mr. Manikandan Srinivasan from Procurement Unit – UNDP concluded the meeting with a vote of thanks to the representatives of the participating agencies.

While applying as JV or consortium, all the roles and responsibilities of every organization must be detailed in the proposal. The final contract will be however in the name of the lead agency, and not JV or consortium. Yes, the individuals/agencies in the consortium need to be working in the space of climate and social entrepreneurship.
2	Sub-themes in the proposal Should the agency suggest sub-themes or will it be decided by UNDP.	We would prefer mentioning the agency's areas of super specialization and other areas that work best for the agency in the proposal.

Legal entity is not necessary, but we prefer someone who is experienced in the entrepreneurship spectrum. While they need not be registered, the focus is on a viable business idea, model or product line. No
4	Age of the organization/ Members What is the upper limit for the age of the start-up or the founders? The founders need to be between the age ground 18 to 29. There must be 2 members in the team and the start-up must be less than 4 years.	
5	 Springboard programme Is the two-day innovation showcase connected with the finale? How is it coincided as the dialogues continue till January, but the incubation ends in December? Is the National Innovation Challenge and National Showcase inter-changeably used? 	 The finale and showcase are related. A combination of the springboard and dialogue forms the Co: Lab. Last 10 days of the springboard and the dialogue will coincide. The Springboard program and the Dialogue will happen simultaneously in December. However, the deliverables we need can be assessed by January. Yes, in that context. It would be designed by the agency in consultation with UNDP. We have some

We may have fixed milestones with modules that would be reviewed every one to two weeks. The basis could be entrepreneur's service-oriented user experience, e-commerce, social media and platform utilization etc.
11	Jury/Expert panel Are there any pre-requisites for deciding on the jury members or does the agency have free reign in deciding on the jury.	Agency is free to propose, the jury members would be approved by UNDP. However, UNDP strongly recommends an equal representation of females in the panel/jury.

We will have 350 applicants out of which the top 40 shortlisted team will go through the National Springboard Following the Innovations Showcase, two winning teams will be identified that will represent India at Regional Summit The Top 5 winning teams that will be part of Regional Springboard and 10 shortlisted teams will get support from the Stakeholder Alliance
13	Sustenance for the members Does UNDP provide any investment?	No, but the agency is free to find partners willing to do that.

We would have some mandatory and elective sessions. The onus of ensuring attendance does not lie on the service providers. However, regular correspondence between the participants and the service provider must be maintained.
17	By when can we expect the contract to be awarded post the submission deadline?	We would inform this within two weeks' time.
18	Would impact of the entrepreneurship be a criterion for the shortlisting process?	The closer the impact is to our theme, the higher is their chance to get selected.
19	How unique must be the idea of the start-up?	We do not expect the idea to be unique or original. Taking inspiration from existing projects is also acceptable.
20	Is it necessary that the start-up be an early start-up?	Yes, four years old is the upper limit.
21	Is there a specific focus on technology start-ups/green entrepreneurship? Can the cohort be mixed?	The cohort can be mixed.
22	 Level of detail in the proposal 1. Should a week wise schedule of the program be given? 2. Do we mention the people that we engage with (as juries or panel)? Should such an indicative list be given in the proposal? 	 You can give a concrete idea of the program panning out, and a month wise timeline would be useful. This need not be mentioned in the proposal. The discussion can happen during the course. Providing an indicative list in the proposal would be useful.
23	Collaborations with other programs of agency Can we leverage resources from the programmes to some other program that the agency is already performing? How separate should the two programs be?	Knowledge exchange between the programmes and cohort is allowed but the programs cannot be merged.
