

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR SPECIAL SERVICE AGREEMENT

TITLE: TRAINING FOR GREEN SCREEN VFX PRODUCTION

Location : Home based and on-site Type of Contract : Individual Contract

1) GENERAL BACKGROUND

To create highest-quality videos, UNDP South Africa is procuring necessary equipment to create a green screen studio towards producing powerful communications products that raise awareness of issues of South Africa's development and showcase the good work of the Country Office (CO).

Composited videos and chroma keying shots – using green screen technology – create professional videos and special effects that blend well with animations and substitute for shooting on location, among many other advantages.

"Green screen" is a visual effects (VFX) technique where two images or video streams are layered—i.e. composited — together. For example, green screen allows the user to drop in any given background image behind a foreground. It is used in film production (and also in news and weather reports) to place any desired background behind the subject/actor/presenter.

"Composited video" is the process of combining two or more video images into one. "Chroma-keying" is the process of isolating a single color or brightness value in an electronic image and then making that value transparent in post-production, allowing another image or footage to be placed "beneath" the color that has been blanked out.

Green Screen VFX Production comprises these skills, among other fundamental workflows.

Towards taking full advantage of this new green screen studio, a consultant for Green Screen VFX Production is required to support hardware setup and conduct software usage training of CO staff.

2) OBJECTIVES OF THE ASSIGNMENT

The green screen studio is currently under construction and will be finished before the consultant's contract commences.

The consultant, in close collaboration and supervision of Resident Representative for UNDP South Africa and the UNDP South Africa Communications Team, will be responsible for

1. Physical, technical setup of the green screen studio, with a specific emphasis on



- lighting/cinematography and robust training of CO staff in these areas, as well as advising on any necessary, outstanding equipment.
- 2. Training on composing camera shots including (not limited to Establishing Shots, Rule of Thirds, Centered/ Wide Angle/ Medium Shots/Close Ups, etc), as well as cinematography, composition, and directing these shots specifically for green screen.
- 3. Training CO staff on VFX software (e.g. Wondershare) for compositing shots, including chroma keying and using video keying effects, like masking, and working with nested sequences and integrating animations among other fundamental software skills, such as troubleshooting for chroma key challenges.
- 4. Working with CO staff to create one short video clip, per staff member, using only green screen shots to communicate a simple idea or message.
- 5. Develop a simplified user manual covering all the key areas covered in the physical training for CO staff to refer from later. The manual should also provide all the tips and tricks on how to utilize the VFX software, lighting, and sound.

3) SCOPE AND STAGES OF WORK ASSIGNMENT

Informed by a syllabus approved by the CO, during the ten (working) day period, the consultant will:

- I. Set up the green screen studio in the CO, with a special emphasis on the technicals of lighting, and train CO staff in this area
- II. Train CO staff on theory fundamentals of lighting/cinematography, shot composition, and directing specifically for the CO green screen studio
- III. Train CO staff on VFX software (e.g. Wondershare) for compositing shots throughout the entire chroma key workflow.
- IV. Work with CO staff to create one short video clip, per staff member, that uses green screen compositions, only
