REPAIR MAINTENANCE PLAN 2021

Introduction:

United Nations Development Programme is soliciting to obtain an experienced Contractor to carry out the repair maintenance work inside UN House in UN Buildings. The repair work mainly include Water Proofing work. Similarly, minor construction and civil work such as Plaster work in non-structural cracks, placement of manhole cover, shedding in emergency staircase, replacement of wooden frames and doors, painting and so on. The detailed ToR for Repair Maintenance plan is included.

Objective:

The primary objective of this contract is to carry out the repair maintenance work as per specification and bidding document.

Scope of Work/Assignment:

- The entire work plan as per RFQ will be implemented in phases.
- Contract will be awarded to the single successful bidder though the work will be done phase wise
- After the successful completion of the Phase 1, next phase will be planned. It is estimated to complete the project within one-year time frame. 50% work will be done in 2021 and remaining 50% in 2022.
- Contractor will carry out the work under direct supervision of the Consultant engineer hired by UNDP
- Contractor will follow the safety protocols and standard practice regarding the civil engineering norms.

Timeline:

The work is split into 3 phases. This phase wise plan is assumed to be complete in one-year time frame. However, this doesn't guarantee the implementation of all the phases in case of any unforeseen situation.

Status:

The contractor shall be considered as having legal status of an independent firm and shall not be considered in any respect as being a member of the United Nations. The rights and obligations of the consultant are strictly limited in articles mentioned in Terms of Reference. Accordingly, the contractor shall not be entitled to any benefit except as expressly mentioned in Terms and Reference and agreement.

Remuneration:

The initial contract will be signed for the phase 1 plan only. Subsequently, upon completion of phase 1, next contract will be issued. The payment to the contractor will be as per the amount mentioned in the contract

document. The amount will be paid upon submitting the phase wise "Work Completion Certificate" that certifies the completion of work in line with the specification and bid documents.

Tax:

The contractor is liable to make the payment of any kinds of tax including the VAT to the government of Nepal that may arise in connection with this service. UNDP is in no way, responsible for the payment of any kinds of taxes in this connection.
