S/L	Queries	UNDP Response
1.	Is it possible to extend the proposal submission deadline considering the challenges the firms are meeting during C-19 Emergency Situation?	Yes. Considering COVID 19 situation, We have extended our time till 10 August 2021 for proposal submission.
2.	Is there any basic change in the ToR than 1st advertisement?	Minor changes were done in the deliverables, Timeline, printing specification and individual expert qualification area.
3.	Can any International firm take the lead as there is one international position-Team Leader?	Yes
4.	Can any national firm join on a JV partner or sub-consultant with another national firm?	Yes
5.	Financial budget can be proposed separately for international & national and can be paid separately in their bank account?	No. Only Lead agency's account will be used for payment against deliverables through EFT (Electronic Fund Transfer).

6.	Can sample sizes be flexible? Or it is fixed?	We expect the bidders to propose same sample size and geographic areas following baseline sample.
7.	Can international expert work from home? If he needs to visit Bangladesh, that should be how many days?	We expect the Team Leader to be an international citizen or dual citizenship (like as Bangladeshi and others international citizenship). Please note that Team leader is responsible for all deliveries over the period, considering that the bidder can decide how many days the team leader should be engaged for ensuring quality outcome. 10.	The Duration of the assignment is 70 days, which means we have to complete the assignment within 100 days. Keeping the corona situation in mind, does UNDP have kept any plan for contingency, like extending the duration of the project?	Yes, we have 70 working days over three and a half (3.5) months. If the COVID situation becomes worse UNDP has a plan for contingency, like extending the duration of the project.
11.	Is it possible to give us an idea about the budget range?	It is entirely up to the bidders' judgement.
