The following inquiries have been received in relation to the above-mentioned process:

Question #1: What secondary information do you have?

<u>Answer to question #1</u>: We have several sources but would like the consultant to include in his work the identification and analysis of his/her own sources. In cases where secondary information is identified but not accessible, we can help with formal requests to authorities. But these are to be discussed during the consultancy period.

Question #2: Confirm if interviews / surveys will be about conducted with:

- Labor and migration officials
- Venezuelan migrants.

<u>Answer to question #2</u>: Mostly with labor and migration officials at this stage. But if possible, we are also opened to consider interview with Venezuelan migrants.

Question #3: Could be the consulting work held virtually 100 /remote?

<u>Answer to question #3</u>: Yes. At the moment due to the sanitary conditions, the work will be done remotely. So, availability to good and stable internet is a must. If conditions allow, we can consider a mission. If this is the case, UNDP will cover travel, and daily subsistence allowed separately.
