1. STRENGTHENING LOCAL CAPACITIES FOR RESILIENCE AND RECOVERY – SLCRR project

“Strengthening Local Capacities for Resilience and Recovery” is a multi-phase, multi-year project that is directly implemented by UNDP Libya and funded mainly by the European Union.

To respond to the many challenges people in Libya are facing, UNDP approach is to help the local authorities to restore security, essential services delivery and livelihoods opportunities putting the country on a more robust development path.

The second phase aims at enhancing provision of basic services at local level and increasing access for most vulnerable groups from host communities – including Internally Displaced Populations (IDPs) and returnees – as well as migrants and refugees. This second phase is implemented in close cooperation with the Ministry of Local Governance, Municipalities, UNICEF and Italian Agency for Development Cooperation (AICS).

To respond to the many challenges people in Libya are facing, UNDP approach is to help the local authorities to restore security, essential services delivery and livelihoods opportunities putting the country on a more robust development path.

2. PROJECT BACKGROUND

Drinking water suitable for domestic use is one of the most important requirements of daily life, and the presence of water in cities and villages is one of the reasons for the urban population that provides a decent life for humanity.

The permanent maintenance of water networks within cities is necessary for the continuity of water flow regularly and to ensure its suitability for use. The maintenance of the water network in remote areas far from the center of the capital is one of the most important projects that help and solve the daily problems of local civilians and contribute to supporting the services provided by the municipalities.

The municipality of Murzuq suffers in many villages under its local administration from poor water supply, as contain very old networks that have not been maintained for several years, and residents must transport water in tanks for daily use.

2.1 Project description

1. Jizau Area :

The water network in Jizau consists of a supply line with a length of 8 km distributed within the village, and this network has not been maintained for more than 13 years, which exposed it to consumption, as well as many random connections that caused a decrease in the pressure rate in the pipes.

2. Heg'Hegel Area :

The water network in Heg'Hegel consists of a supply line with a length of 16 km distributed within the village, and this network has not been maintained for more than 9 years, which exposed it to consumption, as well as many random connections that caused a decrease in the pressure rate in the pipes.

3. Dulaym Area :

The water network in Dulaym consists of a supply line with a length of 27 km distributed within the village coming from nearby water resource at Heg'Hegel Town, and this network has not been maintained for more than 25 years, which exposed it to consumption, as well as many random connections that caused a decrease in the pressure rate in the pipes.

The proposed project is a comprehensive maintenance of the 4-inch main line in some places that have been damaged, as well as maintenance and renewal of some of the sub-connections that were established without referring to the water company, which caused a lack of water access to homes with continuous weakness, especially in summer days.

2.2 Direct and indirect beneficiaries:

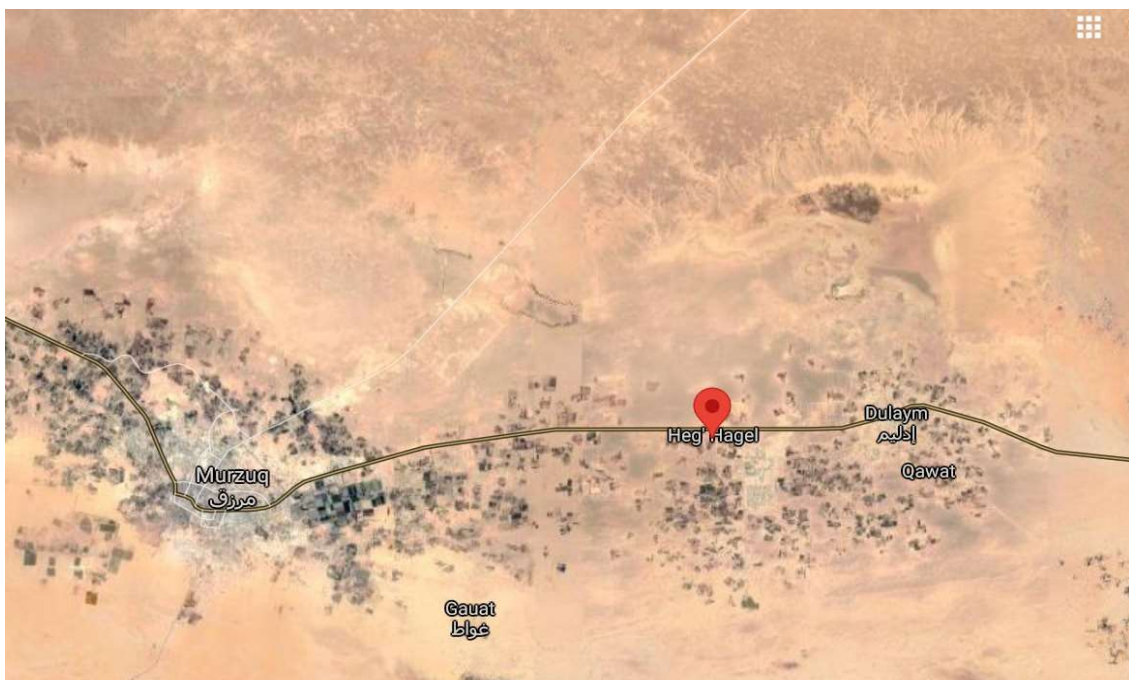
- 1. Jizau Area :** After the completion of this maintenance, the water will flow in full force in the network to reach more than 800 homes and more than 3,500 residents, who previously suffered from weak water. In addition, this project will enable the water company to overcome the weakness of the capabilities it suffers to support this project
- 2. Heg'Hegel Area :** After the completion of this maintenance, the water will flow in full force in the network to reach more than 700 homes and more than 6,400 residents, who previously suffered from weak water. In addition, this project will enable the water company to overcome the weakness of the capabilities it suffers to support this project
- 3. Dulaym Area :** After the completion of this maintenance, the water will flow in full force in the network to reach more than 250 homes and more than 3,100 residents, who previously suffered from weak water. In addition, this project will enable the water company to overcome the weakness of the capabilities it suffers to support this project

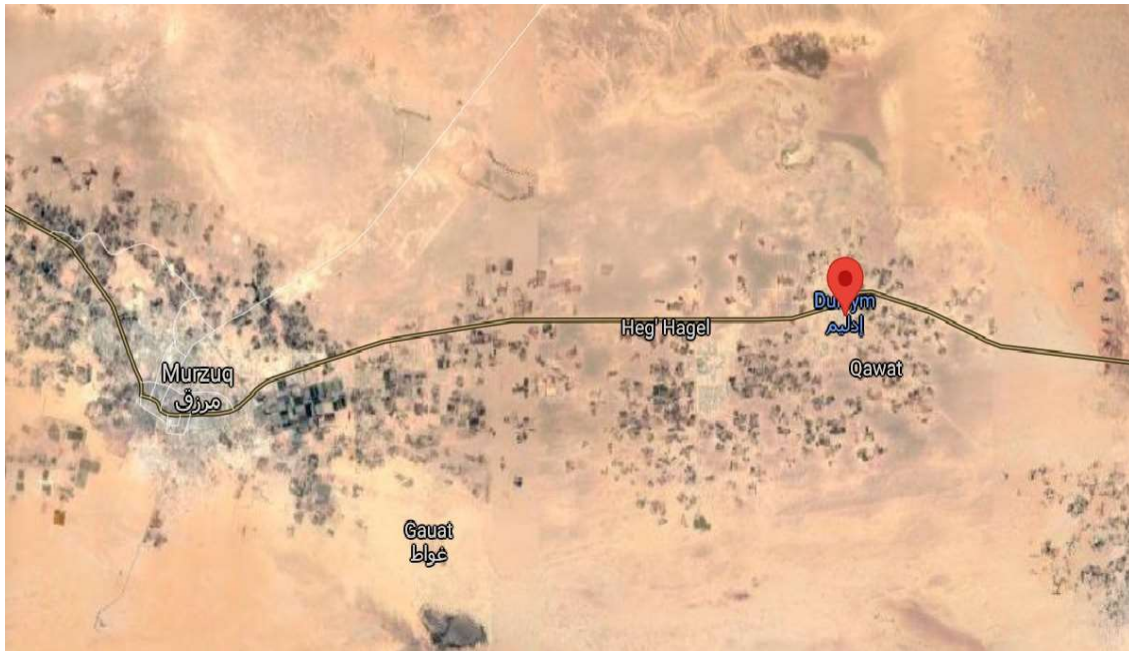
Jizau a village 35 km far East of Murzuq with coordinates (25.875411,14.152644)

4. BUILDING/CONSTRUCTION DESCRIPTION

4.1 Jizau Area: The work consists of digging in the ground of different specifications to remove the previous pipes, as well as maintaining what can be maintained by welding or cutting and changing in a longitudinal distance not exceeding 4 km. This maintenance depends on tracing the path of the pipes from the pumping well to the last point in the network to maintain it and raise the efficiency of productivity.

4.2 Heg'Hagel Area: The work consists of digging in the ground of different specifications to remove the previous pipes, as well as maintaining what can be maintained by welding or cutting and changing in a longitudinal distance not exceeding 2.5 km. This maintenance depends on tracing the path of the pipes from the pumping well to the last point in the network to maintain it and raise the efficiency of productivity.

4.3 Dulaym Area: The work consists of digging in the ground of different specifications to remove the previous pipes, as well as maintaining what can be maintained by welding or cutting and changing in a longitudinal distance not exceeding 4.9 km. This maintenance depends on tracing the path of the pipes from the pumping well to the last point in the network to maintain it and raise the efficiency of productivity.

5. DESCRIPTION OF THE DAMAGE

There are many leakage points in the pipe network, as well as a weakness in the special welding joints as a result of the previous poor service, and there are many random, non-technical connections that caused the network to weaken. In addition, the quality of the previously used tubes is considered to be of poor quality.

6. WORKS ON BRIEF

Below are the important and summary of the required rehabilitation works, for more detail refer to BOQ, the work shall include but not limited to the following:

- a. The works include but not limited to Excavation in different types of ground to a depth of not more than 1.25 meters in the places selected for maintenance according to the existing damage, as well as in places of leakage in the connections and others as indicated on the BoQ.
- b. The works also include but not limited to Laying pipes for the network according to the instructions and completing all connections and testing of leakage and hydraulic pressure of the network, all as per site engineer instruction related to BoQ
- c. Covering the pipe with clean, supplied sandy soil, 35 cm high, and backfilling with clean soil to ground level, according to the instructions of the supervisor engineer and according to the specifications, all as BoQ

7. DURATION OF THE PROJECT

The period of performance for project is one hundred twenty (**120**) calendar days from the site hand over. All work shall be scheduled to complete within this timeframe. Any modifications or extensions shall be requested through the Engineer for review and approval.
