EXISTING SITUATION (RELIEF)

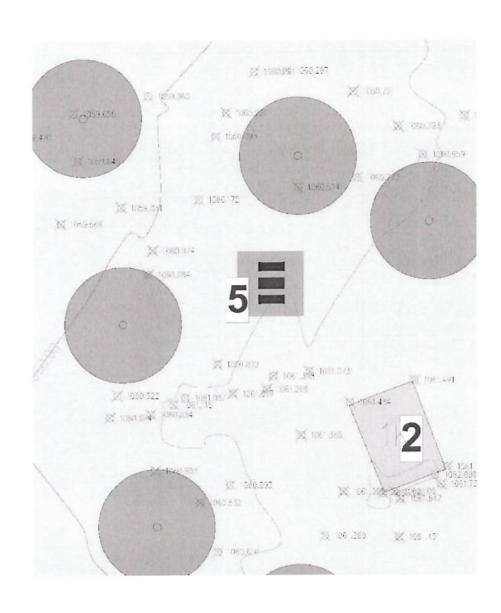




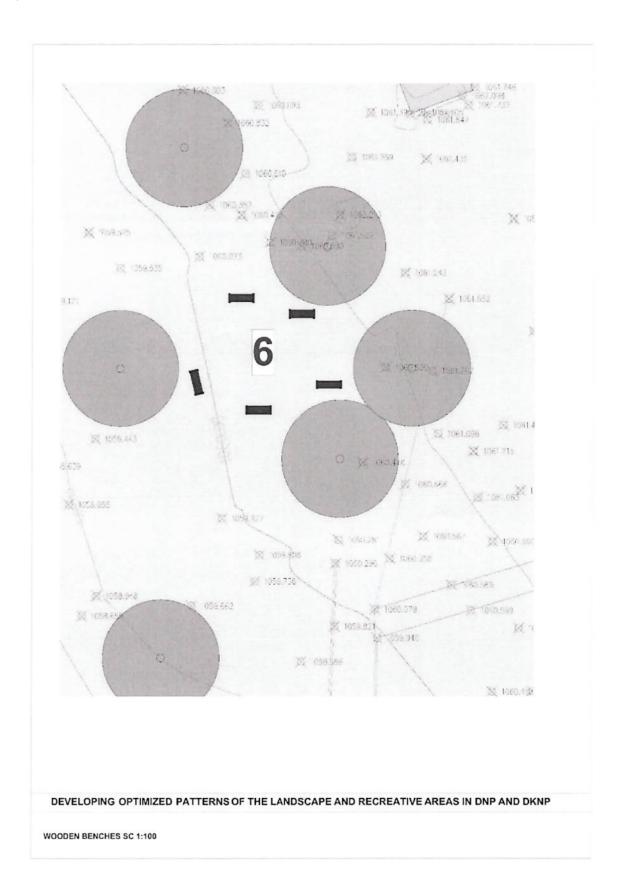


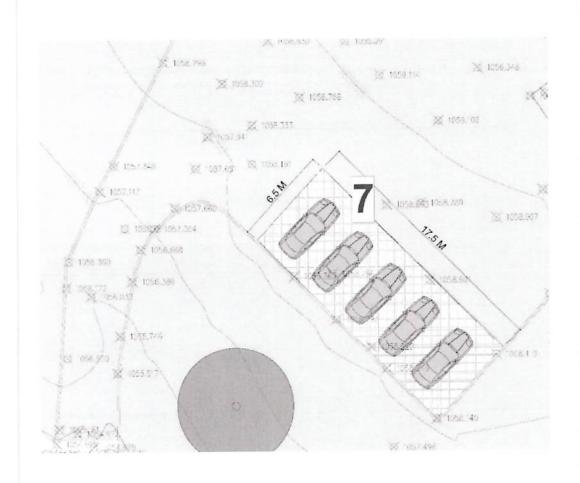


OPEN AUDITORIUM SC 1:100
