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| 1. | Could you please give a bit more of an indication of what each of the innovation hubs? | Innovation hubs would be designed to deliver one-stop shop youth innovation hubs for fostering innovation and entrepreneurship and developing vocational and transferable skills among young people. These hubs provide an integrated end-to-end support service to entrepreneurs from idea generation, start-up to scale-up of businesses. Youth are also supported with training to develop vocational and soft skills; and are supported with mentorship programmes to build their confidence and capacity. Innovation hub services include vocational training services, business training and incubation, business registration and legal advice, financing and financial literacy, innovation camps and challenges, research and leadership development, internships and employment opportunities, internet access and online learning, and e-market platform connecting demand to supply for skills, services, and products. |
