## **ATTACHMENT-1 Answers to Questions received from Prospective Proposers**

Question 1: As per Section 3 Bid Data Sheet, BDS No. 6 at page number 20 of the RFP, Joint Venture / Consortium / Association is not allowed; however, subcontracting is allowed as per the evaluation criteria section 1.1.5 at page number 28 of the RFP. Could you please clarify if submission as consortium will be accepted, or proposers are only allowed to use subcontractor(s)?

Answer 1: As per Section 3 Bid Data Sheet, BDS No. 6 at page number 20 of the RFP, Joint Venture / Consortium / Association is not allowed, so submission as a Joint Venture / Consortium / Association shall not be accepted. However, as per the evaluation criteria section 1.1.5 at page number 28 of the RFP, proposers can use subcontractors; in such case, proposers shall elaborate within their technical proposal on the "extent to which any work would be subcontracted, to whom, how much percentage of the work, the rationale for such, and the roles of the proposed sub-contractors and how everyone will function as a team".

Question 2: In FORM G Financial Proposal Form of the RFP, proposers are expected to quote for out-of-pocket expenses within Ankara Province only. In case of any travel requirement outside Ankara within the Country, who will bear the cost for travel, accommodation, etc.?

Answer 2: Proposers shall quote for out-of-pocket expenses for the assignments to be performed within Ankara Province only. In case, travel out of the Ankara is needed, the travel and accommodation costs of these missions will be borne by UNDP/UNICEF or other participating UN Agencies. It is required that the terms of such travels are approved by UNDP/UNICEF or other participating UN Agencies prior to each travel. The costs of these missions may either be covered through corporate travel agencies of UN Agencies or other corporate daily subsistence allowance practices. In this regard, proposers shall not reflect any cost regarding travel outside Ankara Province, in Financial Proposal Forms.

Question 3: In case of any travel restriction due to COVID 19, is there any possibility that various assignments may be undertaken through virtual mode for verification of documents remotely?

Answer 3: In case of any COVID 19 restrictions on travels, LTA Holder may be requested to undertake assignments remotely through online resources. Prior to initiation of such assignments, terms of arrangements shall be approved by UNDP/UNICEF or other participating UN Agencies.
