ATTACHMENT 1- ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS FROM PROSPECTIVE PROPOSERS

Question 1: An indication of the pilot irrigation area size and the number of deep wells and pump systems to be measured could not be identified in the Terms of Reference for provision of irrigation water. This information would provide us the opportunity to estimate the working days on the pilot irrigation area and corresponding cost of measurement team. Can you please clarify these items in order for us to prepare financial proposal more precisely?

Answer 1: According to the Annex 4: Detailed Terms of Reference, the defined field level measurements and analysis shall be conducted based on the work plan to be proposed by the Contractor. As part of the field level analysis, the measurement of efficiency of wells shall be conducted in either Adıyaman, Şanlıurfa or Mardin provinces of Turkey. The Contractor shall provide the number of wells that the measurements will take place during Phase 2: Conducting the Feasibility. The number of the wells selected, and the selected pilot areas shall be approved by the UNDP. Particularly, it is expected from the Contractor to implement sampling methodology for this assignment. In general, it is expected to conduct measures for 10% of the deep wells in a given selected pilot area. Within this assignment, the measurement shall be conducted for at least 25 deep wells. As clearly stated in Section VIII. Facilities to be provided by UNDP and Duty Station of the Terms of Reference, field level measurements will be conducted in the Region as indicated in Section IV based on the methodology proposed which will be prepared by the Contractor. All additional costs such as travel, accommodation, living or other costs of experts for attending meetings with the UNDP and the GAP RDA as well as all costs of field measurement analysis (including necessary equipment) shall be covered by the Contractor and shall be taken into consideration during preparation of the proposals.
