For international suppliers the following authorization will be requested: - a Wholesale Distribution Authorization for medical devices and pharmaceuticals issued by Afghan medicines authorities (or the equivalent document from Afghan authorities for this activity) OR alternatively - an official letter issued by Afghan authorities clearly stating that the foreign bidder/supplier is authorized to distribute medical devices and pharmaceuticals in Afghanistan. OR alternatively - a Wholesale Distribution Authorization/GDP certificate for medical products issued by a Stringent Regulatory Authority (SRA1).</p> <p>Question: It is hard for Chinese company, China National Medical Product Administration is not a Stringent Regulatory Authority (SRA), and we cannot provide any official letter issued by Afghan authority. Based on this situation, can we participate in this project?</p>	<p>The listed documents are mandatory requirements as per the national regulations. International bidders who do not have this document may consider partnering with a local supplier who can furnish the same.</p>

Delivery/Incoterms: DAP Bidders must be able to deliver ordered Goods within a maximum of 12 weeks from the date of the received purchase order.</p> <p>Question: Due to the required quantity, it is impossible to ship the cargo by Air. If we ship the cargo by sea, the cargo should</p>	<p>Given the urgency of the project, goods must be supplied within 12 weeks as stipulated in the ITB.</p>

<p>arrive at Karachi, Pakistan first, then From FOT Karachi to CPT UNAMA Kabul by land. Based on our experience, from China to Afghanistan it will take at least 3 months for transportation. So, 12 weeks delivery lead time is difficult to meet for Chinese vendor. Is it possible to extend the lead time to 20 weeks?</p>
