• At least 5 years of experience in providing training on SWP, with focus on design, installation, basic operation, maintenance, troubleshooting, repair, and replacement of damaged components of SWP.

#### 4. FINANCIAL PROPOSAL

This is a <u>Lump sum output-based contract</u>. Therefore, the interested offerors are requested to submit <u>Final All-Inclusive Price</u> with cost breakdown.

#### 5. EVALUATION

Offerors will be evaluated based on the **Cumulative analysis**.

• Technical Qualification (100 points) weight; [70%]

• Financial/Price Proposal (100 points) weight; [30%]

A two-stage procedure is utilized in evaluating the proposals, with evaluation of the technical proposal being completed prior to any price proposal being compared. Only the price proposal of the Offerors who passed the minimum technical score of 70% of the obtainable score of 100 points in the technical qualification evaluation will be evaluated.

# 5. 1. Technical qualification evaluation criteria:

The total number of points allocated for the technical qualification component is 100. The technical qualification of the offeror/individual is evaluated based on following technical qualification:

Postgraduate degree in Engineering, economics, applied sciences, public policy, governance or equivalent;	
A minimum of 5 years of working experience in planning, implementing, and managing programs and/or projects in areas of renewable energy, energy access, and applications of solar PV energy. Work experience in similar projects, solar water pumping solutions, would be an advantage;	40
Experience in planning and delivering trainings is required	
Good understanding and/or direct work experience with communities, local government institutions, development agencies such as international organization and/or national or international NGOs, with private sector	20
Fluency in Khmer and English (spoken and written)	
Total Obtainable Score	

Only the offerors who have attained a minimum of 70% of total points will be considered as technical qualified offerors.

# 5. 2. Financial/Price Proposal Comparison:

• Only the financial/price proposal of offerors who have attained a minimum of 70% score in the technical qualification evaluation will be considered and evaluated. The total number of points allocated for the price component is 100. Below is the formula used for this evaluation:

Rating for Financial Proposal = (Lowest Priced Offer / Price of the Offer Being Reviewed) x 100

#### 5.3. Selection Method and Award Criteria:

The award of the contract should be made to the individual consultant whose offer has been evaluated and determined as:

- Responsive/compliant/acceptable, and
- Having received the highest score out of a pre-determined set of weighted technical and financial criteria specific to the solicitation. The total score for each offeror will be calculated

independently by this formula: Total Score = Technical Qualification Score x 70% + Financial Score x 30%
