A - BACKGROUND

UNDP is the UN's global development network, an organization advocating for change and connecting countries to knowledge, experience, and resources to help people build a better life. UNDP is on the ground in about 170 countries and territories, working with national counterparts on solutions to global and national development challenges. In the programme countries, UNDP supports stabilization, state-building, governance and development priorities in partnership with the host governments, the United Nations system, the development partners and other partners to help the country to achieve sustainable development by eradicating poverty in all its forms and dimensions, accelerating structural transformations for sustainable development and building resilience to crises and shock.

UNDP has been a trusted development partner of the Maldives for more than 40 years, helping to achieve the eradication of poverty, reduction of inequalities and exclusion in areas such governance, environment protection, climate change mitigation and adaptation. In each of its thematic areas of work, UNDP at the request of its national partners provides relevant policy advisory support, technical assistance, advocacy, and knowledge to help Maldives achieve its global commitment on Sustainable Development Goals (SDG). With Maldives's transition to Middle Income Country Status, Official Development Assistance from traditional donor sources has been on the continuous decline. UNDP is therefore working with its national partners to identify and tap into alternative and innovative financing mechanisms for development. This process involves broadening outreach and forging wide-ranging partnerships with stakeholders - including other UN agencies, the government, the private sector, philanthropic Foundations, multi-lateral and bi-lateral donors and International Finance Institutions to advance the country's development strategies and objectives.

Maldives has made considerable gains on the economic and human development front in recent years. However, important challenges remain particularly in terms of inclusive participation, accountability, transparency and rights-based approaches in development and governance processes. The equal participation of women in decision-making bodies have been ensured by the Maldives Constitution and laws as well as the international conventions that Maldives is party to. This is supported by commitment from member states to remove barriers that hinder women's participation and to actively promote and ensure their representation and meaningful participation in all governance structures including in the elected and appointed bodies. However, women continue to be underrepresented from decision making processes at local and national level.

In Maldives, only 4 women were elected to the Parliament in 2019 ¹ and 39 women were elected to local councils out of a total 653 members elected in 2017.² However, the amendments to the Decentralization Act have since improved these numbers with the establishment of the 33% quota for women in island and city councils. For the Local Council Elections in 2021, 388 women were elected to island councils indicating the effectiveness of these measures in boosting the participation of women in decision making roles.³

The amendments to the Decentralization Act also strengthen the role of Women's Development Committees as advisory bodies to the local councils. However, during consultations held by UNDP with various stakeholders in 2020, many women identified that there was a substantial need for ongoing capacity development and training programmes for women active in the political arena to build their skills and knowledge to contest for elected positions even between election cycles.

Maldivian youth are driven, creative, and passionate about the communities they live in. UNDP Maldives

Against this background, UNDP in partnership with the People's Majlis implemented a Practice Parliament series in 2021 with the aim of providing opportunities for women and young people to build their capacity and confidence to participate in democratic processes, become change makers in their communities and eventually, contest for elected positions. Building on the success of last year's programme, UNDP and the People's Majlis is currently seeking to hire the venue for the Practice Parliament Program for Youth and Women.

Practice Parliament for Youth is planned to be held from 21 -27 August 2022

Practice Parliament for Women (batch 2) is planned to be held from 4 – 10 September 2022

B - DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Practice Parliament for Youth and Women (batch 2) will host 40 participants from across the Maldives for each program. Venue and catering services are required to cater for the participants and facilitators. Venue must be a PWD friendly or accessible venue.

Scope of Work

The purpose of the Terms of Reference is to provide the service specification for arranging the venue hire and catering services. The firm/vendor will be in-charge of providing the venue hire and catering services to the specified criteria below.
