#### A. General background and justification

In 2021 the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection of Population of the Republic of Kazakhstan (hereinafter – the Ministry) and the United Nations Development Program in Kazakhstan (hereinafter – UNDP) have signed an agreement on the implementation of a joint project "Enhancing Effectiveness of Social Protection Programmes and Improving Access and Participation of Socially Vulnerable Groups" for 2021-2023 (hereinafter – a joint project).

The project is aimed at further supporting the efforts of the Republic of Kazakhstan in improving social policy in accordance with the Strategy "Kazakhstan 2050" and the National Plan for Ensuring the Rights and Improving the Quality of Life of Persons with Disabilities until 2025 (hereinafter – the National Plan).

Ensuring equal access to high-quality social services is defined as one of the tasks of the National Plan<sup>7</sup>.

In the Republic of Kazakhstan, there are 751 state and 164 non-governmental organizations (institutions) that provide special social services to more than 110 thousand people who find themselves in a difficult life situation, in a hospital, semi-hospital, home care and temporary stay (Annex 1 to this Terms of Reference).

Considering the specifics of the contingent of children and adults in these institutions (organizations), the issues of organizing adequate nutrition have particular importance as an important factor in the quality of life, preventing exacerbations, progression of many diseases, and maintaining health.

With the observed growth in the well-being of the country's population, as well as in the context of achieving the Sustainable Development Goals2<sup>8</sup>, it seems important that the norms of food consumption in the institutions (organizations) of the social protection system of the population correspond as much as possible to the physiological needs of the body, the nature of the physical activity and meet modern achievements in nutrition science.

Healthy nutrition - nutrition, taking into account gender, age, the nature of a person's work, natural and climatic conditions, national and ethnic characteristics.

The current natural nutritional norms for persons served in medical and social institutions, rehabilitation centers, educational institutions for children with disabilities, territorial social service centers, day care departments, social adaptation centers<sup>9</sup> (hereinafter referred to as nutritional norms) were developed and aimed at improving nutritional (food) and immune status in the elderly, persons with disabilities and persons without a fixed place of residence.

At the same time, both the list of persons receiving special social services and the network of social service organizations have been expanded in recent years.

- It should be noted that the current nutritional standards do not take into account:
- gender and age characteristics of nutrition in medical and social institutions (organizations);
- do not contain nutritional norms for children from 1.5 to 7 years old receiving special social services;
- do not regulate the issues of therapeutic (dietary) nutrition<sup>10</sup>.

In this regard, it is currently required to improve the existing natural nutritional standards for persons served in organizations (institutions) that provide special social services. At the same time, nutritional standards should not be focused on the type of organization, but on the conditions, mode of stay and categories of recipients of services.

#### B. Implementation and objectives of this assignment

The introduction of new natural nutritional standards will help improve the quality of life of people who find themselves in a difficult life situation and receive services in medical and social organizations of the system of social protection of the population in a hospital, semi-hospital and temporary stay (hereinafter - MSO).

The main objective of this Terms of Reference is to develop:
