Request for Expression of Interest for Contractors to Carry Out the Construction
of School and Health Facilities in Central Sulawesi

UNDP Indonesia invites interested Construction Companies (Contractors) to submit their Expression of Interest (EOI) to participate in the database of Contractors, which to be invited to the upcoming solicitation of bids that is planned to be launched by UNDP Indonesia later in the year for the abovementioned project.

1. Background

In 2018 Indonesia was struck by two particularly severe natural disasters: a 7.0 magnitude earthquake in West Nusa Tenggara (NTB) on 5 August and, less than 8 weeks later - on 28th September - a 7.4 magnitude earthquake, followed by a tsunami and a rare phenomenon known as 'soil liquefaction', in Central Sulawesi.

In Central Sulawesi, over 2,096 people are known to have died as a result of the disaster, with more than 4,438 people seriously injured and 1,373 people missing. 68,451 houses are estimated to have been directly damaged and over 173,522 people are displaced. Affected public service infrastructure includes 176 health facilities (among which two hospitals, in Palu and Parigi Moutong, have been severely impacted) and 1509 education buildings (ranging from elementary schools to universities). Local economic infrastructure has not been immune to damage: 13 market places and 9718 ha of agricultural land have been adversely impacted– with extensive losses being reported in other sectors, such as fisheries and public administration

The Sulawesi/Lombok Programme for Earthquake and Tsunami Infrastructure Reconstructive Assistance (PETRA) is UNDP's response to the recent earthquakes and tsunami in Central Sulawesi and West Nusa Tenggara (NTB) to support the initiatives of the Government of Indonesia in these two (2) provinces.

The project aims to contribute to the rehabilitation and reconstruction of key infrastructures to support the resilient recovery of disaster-affected communities in both provinces in critical public services such as health and education.

In March 2021, PETRA project engaged a construction contractor to carry out the construction of school and health facilities in 19 subprojects located in Palu Municipality (4 locations), Sigi (4

locations), Sigi Kulawi (4 locations) and Parigi Moutong District (7 locations). The works were partially delivered but not completed. To this extent, UNDP will be looking for contractors to complete the unfinished works where the tender document (ITB) will be launched in fourth quarters of 2022.

2. Purpose of the EOI

The purpose of this EOI is to assess interest of potential contractors in upcoming solicitation of civil works for Central Sulawesi in the area of rehabilitation and/or reconstruction of school and health facilities.

Interested Contractors are invited to express interest and provide information about their services, resources, qualifications, experience and financial strength. UNDP Indonesia will develop a database that may be further subjected to detailed review of eligibility and qualifications at the time of solicitation through an open international competition.

4. EOI Format and Submissions

Interested Contractors must submit the following documents:

1. A cover letter with the company's letterhead/logo, duly signed by the authorized official. The cover letter should indicate your preferred work location in Central Sulawesi.
2. Company profile (should be not more than 15 pages), including latest company's organizational chart and quality assurances, if any;
3. List of previous contracts similar and related to the abovementioned works, including contract value, duration and contracting agency/company in the last 7 years;
4. Valid Chamber of Commerce registration/Company registration;
5. Business License or Business Entity Certificate (SBU) with qualifications and building classification requirements
6. References from 3 clients for satisfactory and timely completion of projects; and
7. Evidence of Financial Strength by submitting audited financial statements showing the firm's total and current assets and liabilities for the latest 3 financial years (2018 – 2019; 2019 – 2020; 2020 – 2021 or 2021 – 2022 as applicable).

There will be no reimbursement for any costs incurred by the Contractors in the preparation and submission of the abovementioned documents. These costs are expected to be shouldered by the respective Contractors.

The Contractors shall furnish documentary evidence as required above and complete the questionnaire and submission forms provided in Annex 1 and 2 of the REOI.

5. Submission Details

Interested Contractors are requested to submit all the required documents mentioned in Article 4 above through email to bids.id@undp.org on or before 31 August 2022 at 17.00 hour (GMT+7).

EOIs received after the deadline will not be considered. EOIs of Contractors failing to provide the required documents will be automatically disregarded.
