Recommendations would then either be theme based or country cluster based. A proposed methodology is expected of how the NGO would frame the report, and how best to structure or present the data taking which takes into account political sensitivities. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Specific risks and constraints in each country (as well as Identification of “red lines” = controversial topics in each country);• Identification and profiling of at least 3 potential local partners • Training needs and interests of youth;• Policy areas of interests among youth;• Obstacles to youth civic engagement and participation in governance;• Youth individual attitudes (i.e. Identity, Trust in Institutions; Social Cohesion, participation, and engagement; Interpersonal trust and tolerance).
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
