

Program overview

Women Peace & Humanitarian Funds (WPHF): A global pooled funding mechanism that aims to reinvigorate action and stimulate a significant increase in funding for women's participation, leadership and empowerment in peace and security processes and humanitarian response.

The partnership between the Women's Fund for Peace and Humanitarian Action (WPHF) and the **Spotlight Initiative** aims to:

- ✓ Direct funds to civil society organizations working to end violence against women and girls (EVAWG) in humanitarian and conflict contexts.
- ✓ Support the achievement of Outcome 6 of the Spotlight Initiative Regional Results Framework (strengthening CSOs and building women's movements) and **WPHF Outcome 5** (protection of women's security and rights).

Expected results of the program in Haiti

- ✓ **Spotlight Outcome 6:** Effective impact on gender equality and women's empowerment (GEWE) and the elimination of violence against women and girls (EVAWG), including domestic violence.
- ✓ **Outcome 5 of the Women, Peace and Humanitarian Funds (WPHF):** Reducing acts of violence, facilitating access to services for victims of violence and strengthening accountability mechanisms.
- ✓ **Outcome 3 of WPHF:** Emergency response window

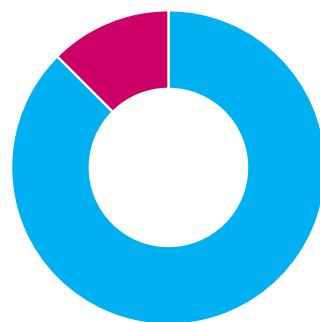

■ WPHF+Spotlight 88 % ■ Fenêtre d'urgence: COVID 12 %

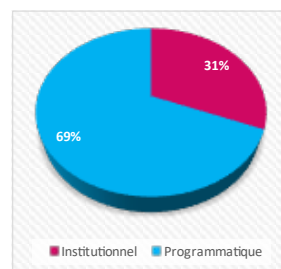
Grants per type of CSO
