

## **ZVBP Small Grants Responses to Requests for Clarifications**

1. Can a private company undertaking community-based projects apply for the ZVBP Small Grant 2022?
  - Private organisations are not eligible for small grants.
2. For Hurungwe, is the ZVBP restricted to Wards 7,8 and 9 only as specified in the baseline report?
  - Yes, the ZVBP is restricted to Wards 7, 8, and 9 in Hurungwe District.
3. Does the project cover Victoria Falls in the Hwange District?
  - The ZVBP does not cover Hwange District.
4. Are organizations that are funded by GEF-SGP eligible to apply?
  - Yes, organisations that received funding from GEF-SGP are eligible to apply.
5. If an organization chooses one thematic area, is it mandatory that the project should cover all the 3 districts, or it is allowed to even focus on one district?
  - It is not mandatory to cover three districts. Applicants can choose one or more districts in the project area.
6. Is the US\$150,000.00 the maximum figure even when focusing on one district?
  - US\$150,000.00 is the maximum but applicants are encouraged to apply for funding that is proportionate to the proposed intervention and budget. It is permissible to apply for amounts less than US\$150,000.00.
7. Are projects that focus mainly on solar powered boreholes for irrigation by small scale women farmers with the mission of enhancing food security eligible?
  - All innovative projects that address SFM, CBNRM, SLM, and HWCM amongst other key result areas as highlighted in the call for proposals are eligible for funding.
