88	<p>Please note that we have case studies and live solutions available for Case Scenarios 1 &amp; 2 as mentioned in the RFP document. And our solution is being used by more than a million farmers in country x. We also have sufficient documentary evidence to support Case Scenarios 1 &amp; 2.</p> <p>However, for Case scenario 3 we have our own proprietary software called ABCD built using block chain technology. This solution is available but we are not in a position to submit documentary evidence.</p> <p>Thus we need your permission to either bid against Case Scenarios 1 &amp; 2 only (excluding case scenario 3) or bid against all three Case Scenarios subject to relaxation in the documentary evidence for Case Scenario 3 only.</p> <p>Kindly let us know and we shall be very happy to bid as the subject quoted in the RFP is similar to what we are already doing for various ministries of the Government of Country x.</p>	<p>The cases included in the RFP are intended to assess how the bidders propose approaching and tackling each of the three outlined scenarios in a manner such that the expected deliverables / outputs are achieved. These are in fact all hypothetical cases that will be used exclusively for RFP evaluation purposes, as outlined in the RFP.</p> <p>All bidders are requested, therefore, to develop and submit their proposed technical and financial proposals in response to each of the three case scenarios presented. They need to outline accordingly their relevant bidder's qualification, capacity and experience, proposed methodology / approach and implementation plan, as well as the details of the management structure and key personal that they propose to assign to the resolution of each of the three scenarios detailed in the RFP (see guiding format in Form E). The corresponding three financial proposals shall detail the costing proposed to develop each of the solutions, and in accordance with the details and information requested in Form G included in the RFP.</p>
89	<p>Based on our detailed review of the Tender document, we observed that the mentioned case scenarios are illustrative or hypothetical cases and there may be a possibility that the actual awarded scenarios may vary from the same. Request to please lend clarity on the same. Is it correct for us to understand that the selected party will be awarded the scenarios almost the same as mentioned in the document, i.e Carbon Registry Platform, etc. ?</p>	<p>It is correct, the selected vendor is highly likely to start the engagement on this LTA on projects similar to those described in the case scenarios. However, the scope of the LTA is not limited to those specific cases and will be used for more projects that will require similar design and development capabilities and approaches.</p>

90	While developing our approach and methodology towards each of the described case scenarios, we anticipate the need for additional time than the number of days stipulated for respective scenarios in the Tender document. We intend to share explanation in the respective technical proposals in order to substantiate the need. We would like to confirm if this hinders our chances of being considered during the selection.	The number of days stated in the case scenarios is only indicative of the level of detail/effort expected. The bidders are expected to suggest the actual number of days they estimate to be required for the completion of the deliverables.
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
