1. BACKGROUND

The key role of the stress counsellor will be to provide psychosocial support services to UN staff operating in the country and to improve stress and critical incident stress management preparedness (as per the UN policy on Management of Stress and Critical Incident Stress, MSCIS-2015) of the UN security management system (UNSMS) in case of emergencies.

2. SCOPE OF WORK, RESPONSIBILITIES AND DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED ANALYTICAL WORK

3. REQUIREMENTS FOR EXPERIENCE AND QUALIFICATIONS

II. Years of experience:

- Additional certification in alcohol/substance abuse and / or suicide prevention is desirable.
- Familiarity with UN policies on Management of Stress and Critical Incident Stress is desirable.

Note:

- Applicants of 65 years or more require full medical examination and statement of fitness to work to engage in the consultancy.
- The candidate has to be an independent consultant (If the candidate is engaged with any organization, the organization employing the candidate will be issued with a Reimbursable Loan Agreement (RLA) to release the employee for the consultancy with UNDP.)

• Due to sheer number of applicants, the procurement unit will contact only competitively selected consultant.

5. FINANCIAL PROPOSAL

Lump sum contracts

The financial proposal shall specify a total lump sum amount, and payment terms around specific and measurable (qualitative and quantitative) deliverables (i.e. whether payments fall in installments or upon completion of the entire contract). Payments are based upon output, i.e. upon delivery of the services specified in the TOR. In order to assist the requesting unit in the comparison of financial proposals, the financial proposal will include a breakdown of this lump sum amount.

6. EVALUATION

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Cumulative analysis

When using this weighted scoring method, the award of the contract should be made to the individual consultant whose offer has been evaluated and determined as:

- a) responsive/compliant/acceptable, and
- b) Having received the highest score out of a pre-determined set of weighted technical and financial criteria specific to the solicitation.

Only candidates obtaining a minimum of 49 points in technical evaluation would be considered for the financial evaluation.
