

Auction of Common Services (CS) /United Nations Volunteer (UNV) - Security Scanners

The UN Bonn Common Services (CS) under the UNV programme wishes to auction two security scanners. The sale will be conducted via sealed envelope bids.

The scanners are as follows:

1. Security scanner - smith heimann Xray HI-Scan, HYME4-Specific Equipment (75821).
Good condition (from 2007), last maintained in December 2022 and fully operational. Available to buyer as of end of March 2023 to arrange the pickup from the current location in Bonn.
Minimum Bid: 2,000 Euro.
2. Security scanner – smith heimann Xray HI-Scan 7551i, HYME4-Specific Equipment (75335).
Very good condition (from 2012), last maintained in December 2022 and fully operational.
Available to buyer of end of March 2023 to arrange the pickup from the current location in Bonn.
Minimum Bid: 1,000 Euro.

How to bid

Please complete and sign the bid form attached, indicating the scanner you are bidding for with your highest offer. Your bid must be signed and sealed in a non-transparent envelope and addressed to:

For external bidders, it is recommended to send the bid by courier or registered mail. UN staff can pass their bid to the Langer Eugen mailroom, where the envelope will be registered (Name, time and date received).

Please write on the envelope **BID-SECURITY SCANNERS NOT TO BE OPENED – Scanner No: 1 or 2**

Bids must be **received no later than 4.30 pm (CET) on 15 March 2023**. Bids submitted after this time will not be considered. Bids will be opened by a bid opening committee and recorded for transparency.

The scanners will be sold to the highest qualified bidder.

The scanners will be available to view on Monday, 13 March 2023, at 9.00 a.m. in Bonn, Germany.

Queries should be put in writing to CS.ICT@unbonn.org. Bids sent by email will be disqualified.

Once the highest bidder is announced, the bidder will have 7 days from the notification to transfer the money to the UNV bank account. Once the money is received, the bidder will be notified when they can pick up the scanner/s. The successful bidder is expected to arrange pick up and any documentation required to pick up the scanners from the UN location.

Both scanners are sold without guarantee, CS/UNV will not accept any returns.
