No.	Queries	Response
1	<p>Do you know how much the tax will be to be paid?</p> <p>Are there other fees that need to be paid other than the 12% tax?</p>	<p>Value added tax (VAT) will be equivalent to 12% of the bid amount.</p> <p>Vehicle needs to be registered by the winning bidder with the Land Transportation Office (LTO) in the same manner as a regular non-tax exempt private vehicle. Interested buyers may directly inquire from LTO on actual cost of this. There will also be minimal amount to be paid for documentary stamps.</p>
2	<p>If the units to be disposed have diplomat plate, does it have to be registered into local regular plate with LTO to be able to use legally as non-diplomat?</p>	<p>Yes, the vehicle needs to be registered for a regular license plate with Land Transportation Office (LTO), UNDP will process and secure endorsement for the conversion. Winning bidder then needs to register the vehicle as regular private vehicle locally, and will be responsible for all costs.</p>
