## 4. EVALUATION

Individual consultants will be evaluated based on the following methodologies:

## Cumulative analysis

When using this weighted scoring method, the award of the contract should be made to the individual consultant whose offer has been evaluated and determined as:

- a) responsive/compliant/acceptable, and
- b) Having received the highest score out of a pre-determined set of weighted technical and financial criteria specific to the solicitation.
- \* Technical Criteria weight; 55%
- \* Interview with candidates; 15%
- \* Financial Criteria weight; 30%

Only candidates obtaining a minimum of 49 points in the technical evaluation would be considered for the Financial Evaluation.

UNDP Electoral Support Project (ESP) to the Election Commission of Nepal has been providing support since 2008. UNDP-ESP has been providing support to ECN in the areas of logistics, infrastructure, equipment and Information Technology is one of the key thematic areas of support to ECN.

UNDP-ESP is managed by a Project Manager (Chief Technical Advisor) and under the overall guidance and direct supervision of the IT Team Leader, the Senior Java Developer is responsible for further developing the Voter List Application (VLA) system and rolling out in production environment. S/he will have hands-on role analyzing, diagnosing and correcting performance problems, designing and implementing functionality, and fixing application defects as per the RFP and deploys into production environment in the Datacenter and Disaster Recovery site. S/he is required to transfer the knowledge to the Technical team of Election Commission of Nepal (ECN) during the development process and further train the IT staff of ECN in managing and maintaining the technology deployed in DC and DR. S/he promotes a collaborative, client-oriented approach consistent with UNDP rules and regulations. The senior Java developer works as part of UNDP-ESP IT Unit team and in collaboration with other developers.
